TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By submitting his or her work for consideration of publication by PJPF, Inc. doing business as The Piedmont Journal of Poetry and Fiction, author agrees as follows:

1. Definition of “work”: A work for the purposes of this agreement is any written (to include digital files) or otherwise permanently recorded intellectual property, including but not limited to, poems, short stories, novels, essays, photos, films, scripts, screen plays, compilations or other creative writings or recordings.
2. Grant of rights: PJPF shall have unlimited, exclusive first rights to publish the accepted work on the website, in social media, in the quarterly Journal or the annual Journal without further compensation to the Author. PJPF shall have the right of first refusal on any second, subsidiary or collateral rights.
3. Reasonable cooperation: Author agrees to cooperate reasonably with PJPF, Inc. to implement any term or provision of this agreement, including the execution of any related instruments or other agreements.
4. Original Ownership: Author certifies that he or she owns or holds the original rights to the submitted work, or otherwise has legal permission to submit the work for publication.
5. Indemnity: Author agrees that if he or she doesn’t own or hold the rights to the submitted work, and PJPF is sued or someone makes a claim against PJPF because PJPF published the submitted work, then Author will reimburse PJPF for any legal costs incurred to defend any such claim or suit.
6. Editorial license: PJPF may condition publication of a submitted work on the author’s incorporation of edits.
7. Feedback: Not all submitted works will receive feedback but some may. Authors are encouraged to resubmit edited works.
8. Submission Guidelines: Author certifies that he or she has read the submission guidelines and certifies that the work conforms to the guidelines.
9. This agreement is made in Virginia and governed by Virginia law. Any disputes related to this agreement will be brought in the Circuit Court for Prince William County, Virginia.
