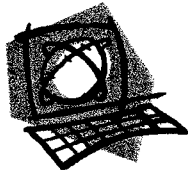

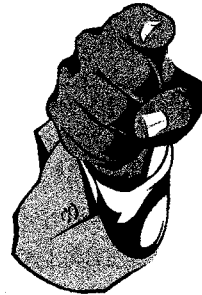

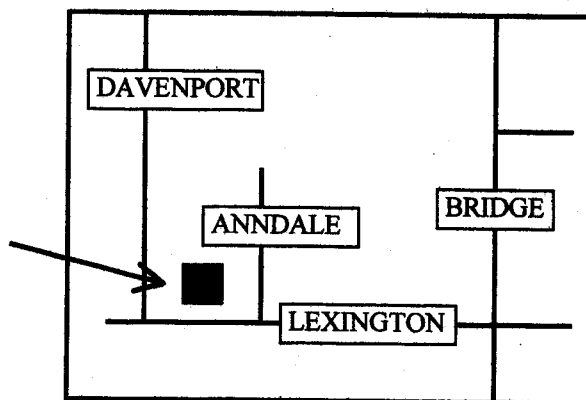


# General Meeting Notice
