The applicant should be careful to sketch all distinct white markings as accurately as possible, since the markings indicated on these diagrams will be reproduced on the certificate of registry of this animal, exactly as they are drawn on this application. It is suggested that the applicant should first sketch the markings with sharp pencil, then check them for accuracy while the animal is still before them, then retrace the sketch with pen & ink. It is suggested that the feet and legs of the animal be washed to determine correct markings. Follow the guide given below in describing the color and distinguishing marks of the animal on line 4 on the other side of this application. If color of mane & tail differs from body color, it should be described on line 4 of the application.

- B-Right hind leg
- C-Left hind leg
- D-Left fore leg
- 1-Hoof
- 2-Coronet
- 3-Pastern
- 4-Fetlock
- 5-Knee

**Sketch on the diagram below all distinct white markings on face, nose, and lips, which can be seen when directly in front of the animal.**

White in forehead above the eye-line may be described as a "star". White extending down over the face may be described as a "stripe" and should be further described by locating the point in forehead or face where it begins and the point on the face where it ends. White or flesh colored spot on upper or lower lip may be described as a "snip". Applicants should be careful to describe any markings on the lower lip. The dotted lines on the diagram are to serve as guides in locating the face markings.
