Hutchison Elementary School

School property is NOT Public property open for general use!

As summer approaches, Hutchison Elementary School would like to reiterate to the adjoining neighborhoods the rules of using the school property in order to keep all students safe during both the summer school hours and the standard school year.

No one is allowed on school property during school hours unless coming for a specific reason such as voting or attending a public meeting.

School Year hours for no access on school property:

Before 6:30 p.m. in the evening during the school year.

Summer hours for no access on school property from July 7th to August 1st:

Before 3:30 p.m.

No one may walk between the trailers and the building ever.

You may walk behind the trailers, on the fields, or on the sidewalk in front of the school during non-school hours.
