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Street Light Outage Repairs

As many of you have noticed, there are numerous street lights out throughout our neighborhood, some for a very extended period of time. The Board of Directors has been aware of this issue and initially contacted the Association's electrician, who verified that the problem is with the underground wiring, and not with the light poles themselves. The issue was repeatedly reported to Dominion Virginia Power, with no response.

A few months ago, the Board enlisted the help of John Foust's office to deal with Dominion. Recently, Supervisor Foust's office connected a Dominion liaison to work with us in solving the problem. The liaison has contacted the Association and informed us that, although the underground lines stem from the Dominion cobra lights, Dominion is taking the position that the underground lines are the property of the Association, and therefore they have been closing out each repair ticket as soon as they have been opened.

The Association has now contracted with an electrician to have all of the underground lines repaired/replaced.

The repair work is scheduled to commence immediately after the holidays and all streets affected will be repaired.
