The Annual Architectural Review is Here (almost)

As March rolls into town and the cold -hopefully- begins to retreat the time for spring cleaning is here! Many of us will open the windows for the first time in months, let the warm air help kick out the dust, and begin a little light outdoor gardening.

Last month we reminded you that the annual architectural review is coming - now's a great time to start thinking about what might need to be cleaned up or repaired before the inspections get to your street. We know a letter from the Architectural Control Committee and Sequoia Management is not what you want in your mailbox so we hope you'll take a few minutes as the warm weather begins to come through and look for these potential issues in your neighborhood:

Spring Cleaning

- Front doors are worn or damaged
- Screen doors are busted
- Alcoves are cluttered
- Tress and bushes are overgrown
- Exterior carpets that are in public view are NOT allowed



Time for a Repair

- Windows don't match
- Fences are in disrepair
- Sidewalks are cracked and pushed up from the freezing water or roots
- Numbers aren't displayed on the back of your house or aren't big enough. (Numbers on fences are NOT allowed.)

If you see our volunteer inspectors in your neighborhood please remember: they are not paid professionals; however, they may be your neighbor and they are a resident in this community.
