Herndon Swim League - Definitions and Terms to Use

25's One length of the pool – 25 meters (or yards).
50's Two lengths of the pool – 50 meters (or yards).
100's Four lengths of the pool – 100 meters (or yards).

Caravan Reflection swimmers and parents meet in the pool parking lot to travel together

to the opponents' pool.

Dual Meet A swim meet between two teams. One team is designated the home or host team.

Event Stroke, Distance and Age Group of swimmers (i.e., Event 28, 9-10 Girls, 50m

Free)

Free Relay A relay event where the 4 swimmers each swim the specified distance of any

desired stroke (generally freestyle). In a 100 meter relay, each swimmer will swim 25 meters; in a 200 meter relay, each swimmer will swim 50 meters.

Heat In most pools, only 6 swimmers may swim at a time. If more than 6 swimmers

qualify to swim for an event, they will be placed in separate heats according to

times.

Home Meet A meet swum at the home pool.

IM Individual Medley or IM is an event where one swimmer swims the specified

distance in all four strokes, in order: Fly, Back, Breast and Free.

Invitational Meet A league meet where certain swimmers are invited to participate, usually based

on qualifying times in an event.

Medley Relay A relay event where the 4 swimmers take turns swimming the specified distance

in each of the four strokes, in order: Back, Breast, Fly, Free.

Mixed-Age Relay A relay event where 4 swimmers representing different age groups, swim the

specified distance, in order.

Officials Trained parent volunteers who ensure that swim meets are operated according to

the League rules in a safe and fun manner. Officials in the Herndon Swim League include: Referee, Starter/Announcer, Head Timer, Stroke and Turn Judge, Relay Judge, Clerk of Course, Timer, Runner and Scorer. Other jobs

include Concessions, Team Area Manager, Set-up and Clean-up.

Relay A relay is a team event involving 4 swimmers that must swim the specified

stroke and distance, one at a time until all 4 swimmers have finished. The time is

based on when the 4th swimmer reaches the finish line.

Relay Carnival A swim meet where Relays are only events.

Tri-Meet A swim meet with three teams participating. One team is host team.
