Both gables have elaborately carved finials. Main gables cut metal decoration. Gablet has carved barge boards. Coloured window panes only other decoration of note.</p> <p><b>History:</b>          Land surveyed for Presbyterian school in 1847, and for already extant church in 1847. Earlier church replaced by present building in 1906.</p> <p><b>Significance:</b>          Some architectural interest. Also has local historical and streetscape value.</p>
