







FUN FACT #1

Uncle Sam's Monument located at the intersection of 3rd and River Stret was dedicated October 18, 1980. The marking of "US" on the heads of packing barrels during the war of 1812 gave rise to the symbol of Uncle Sam.

FUN FACT #2

Troy's first court house and jail built in 1793 were the first buildings constructed with bricks from the Wilson brother's brickyard. This building now houses the Rensselaer County Supreme Courthouse located at 80 2nd Street.

FUN FACT #3

The First Baptist Church of Troy is where Uncle Sam attended services and at times served as Trustee. This building now houses the Tau Nu Chapter of Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity at 82 3rd Street.
