# Heifer Classic Show

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. To be eligible for this show, all heifers must have been born in 2016.
2. **Entry Fee** is \$65.00 per entry and must accompany the entry form. Any entry that is not accepted will be returned and the entry fee will be fully refunded.
3. **Late Entries** will be accepted until July 10, 2017 at the cost of \$100.00 per entry.
4. **Environment Fee** \$5.00 + .25 G.S.T. per animal, total \$5.25
5. For the purpose of this classification an exhibit shall be interpreted as follows:
  - A. Heifers will be split into classes by birth date, shown youngest to oldest. The number of classes will be determined after entries close.
  - B. All entries must be owned by name of the exhibitor at the time of making the entry.
6. Prize money will be distributed as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Place - \$100.00
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Place - \$80.00
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Place - \$65.00
7. The first and second place exhibits in all classes will compete for the Supreme Champion honour.

# Classic Steer Stake

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. **All steers must abide by CCIA rules and regulations.**
2. **Environment Fee** \$5.00 + .25 G.S.T. per animal, total \$5.25
3. All steers will be allocated into classes by weight. Subject to the number of entries received, there will be a maximum of 9 entries in any one class.
4. All entries must be under 22 months of age. Age will be determined by the dentition process. The two central incisors, as permanent teeth, may be up and in wear. The adjoining central incisors cannot be up and not in wear. The dentition's decision will be final with no right of appeal.
5. The owners of the Grand and Reserve Champion will have the first right of refusal to keep their steers. If the exhibitor wishes to take the first right of refusal the monies that they will receive will be \$3,500.00 for Grand Champion and \$1,750.00 for Reserve Champion. For the sponsors draw 1<sup>st</sup> will receive \$1,500.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> will receive \$1,250.00 and 3<sup>rd</sup> will receive \$500. The draw will be made from the list of show sponsors and the draw will take place at ringside immediately after the Champion class. The results of the draw will be final.
6. All clipping chutes must be properly identified with owners name. A designated clipping area will be allowed during the show. **NO CLIPPING WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE ALLEYS.**

**Contribution is \$110.00 per steer, non-refundable, to be received in the office by 5:00 p.m. on or before July 5, 2017.**

# GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION

1. The show will be held under the management of the Lloydminster Agricultural Exhibition Association Ltd.
2. The show is open to all, but the Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry.
3. The Committee in Charge reserve the right to decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make any necessary alterations in the Rules and Prize List.
4. **Unethical fitting of cattle entered for competition is prohibited.**
  - a. For the purpose of this show, any treatment or operation materially altering the structure or the natural conformation of any part of the animal's body such as the introduction of air, liquids or other substances subcutaneously in any part of the body, surgical operation to exaggerate the natural conformation of the animal. Any products/solutions/liquid administered internally to alter the conformation or weight of the animal is prohibited. Balancing the udder by artificial means is prohibited.
5. Order of events subject to change by the Program Committee. Exhibitors are requested to watch progress of the judging called into the ring. Animals must be in the show ring promptly after being called. Exhibitors failing to comply with this rule will have their animals excluded.
6. All animals being exhibited must be halter-broken and must be securely tied or in the charge of a competent person. No animals shall be allowed to remain loose on the grounds. **NO ANIMAL SHALL BE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS THAT IS NOT ENTERED FOR THE SHOW.**
7. All animals on the grounds will be subject to veterinary inspection if necessary. No animal having a contagious disease shall be allowed to occupy any stall or building on, or be admitted to, the Exhibition grounds, and if any animal has been admitted through an oversight, suffering from any such disease, the Manager shall immediately order its removal from the grounds.
8. No person will be allowed to act as judge who is in any way interested in the exhibits that person is to judge. No person other than officials, stewards and attendants on duty, and the judge of the class may enter the show ring without the permission of the management.
9. The Exhibitors and grooms are to appear in the ring, neat, clean and suitably attired.
10. No animals shall have on or about it any prize colours or cards until the awards have been made in their respective classes.
11. No animal shall be considered by the Judges in awarding prizes unless the Exhibitor's number is conspicuously displayed.
12. Animals winning prizes must not leave the ring until the prize has been awarded to them.
13. In the absence of competition in any section, or if the livestock exhibited are of inferior quality, the Judges will award only such premiums as they think the animals deserve. They will use their own discretion as to whether they will award first, second or any prize.
14. No substitutions or refund of entry fee will be permitted, unless the animal has become sick, injured or deceased – a certificate from a veterinarian must verify this.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained, it is understood that each entrant by the act of entry or exhibiting waives all claims against the Lloydminster Agricultural Exhibition Association Ltd., and/or any of the members, officers or agents thereof for any injury, loss or damage which he, his employees, helpers and/or property may sustain in any way arising out of the operations or activities of the said Company, by any of his helpers or employees or their executors, administrators or assigns, and that any helpers or assistant introduced to or engaged by the entrant through the said Company or through its members, officers or agent shall be at the sole risk and responsibility of such entrant.

Exhibitors of animals are liable to occasional accidents, injury or damage to persons coming into contact with them, and therefore shall guard their exhibitors and protect the public from coming in contact herewith, and every such exhibitor shall indemnify the Lloydminster Agricultural Exhibition Association Ltd. from and against all claims and demands, costs, charges

and expenses which it may incur, suffer or be put to, by reason of an accident or of any such exhibit not being properly guarded or the public not being protected there from. The Directors and Committee Members, will be taking every precaution, cannot hold themselves responsible for any damage to or loss of exhibits.

All protests shall be made in writing and accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00 which deposit shall be forfeited if protest is not sustained. Said protest shall state plainly the cause of the complaint or appeal and shall be filed with the Secretary the same day as the decision complained of is made and no later than 7:00 p.m., July 13, 2017 for the heifer and steer shows. The Committee in charge of the department in which the protest is made, as soon as they may deem best, shall deal with such protest and the decision shall be final. In event of the Committee being unable to come to a decision, the Board of Directors shall deal with the protest.

Should any question or dispute arise, not provided for in the rules, it shall be referred to the Committee in charge.

## **STOCK EXHIBITORS TICKETS – GATE ADMISSION POLICY**

All stock exhibitors and display exhibitors will be required to have gate admission passes which may be ordered when entries are submitted. The pre-fair price is \$40.00 for a four-day pass. Four-day passes will not be sold at admission gates. Exhibitors may buy them at the Exhibition Office prior to fair days or on the first fair day **ONLY**.

Stock Exhibitors may also purchase one-day gate admission passes when entries are submitted. The pre-fair price is \$10.00 for a one-day pass.

### **Camping Fees**

\$30.00 + GST per day for 30 amp power sites, \$20.00 + GST per day for 15 amp power site, \$15.00 + GST per day per non-electrical site. First come first serve basis. Campers must register with Exhibition representative in the camping area.
