DESCRIPTION OF SCHOLARSHIP	<p>One scholarship shall be awarded annually to a senior competitor who is successful in the Senior Showmanship Class with first place. The Scholarship is exclusively for Agriculture related post-secondary education. These career choices include any that focus on various agricultural areas, as well as anything that is intended to improve the quality of rural life. \$500 of this scholarship can be used towards 4-H judging competitions. \$200 of the \$500 will be available to the successful competitor to help cover the expenses of competing in the Saskatchewan Provincial 4-H judging competition. The remaining \$300 of the \$500 will be available for the senior if they are successful at the provincial competition and wish to go on to the Canadian National 4-H judging competition at Agribition to help cover expenses. The expenses for the provincial/National competitions that the funds can be used towards are gas/meals/entry fees. If the successful competitor is not a 4-H member or does not qualify to go to the competitions then the full \$1500 will still be available for use towards post-secondary education. ELIGIBILITY	<p>Senior competitors who meet the following criteria shall be eligible for this scholarship. The applicant:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Needs to be the age required for the Senior Showmanship Class at Junior Exhibitor Female show at Stockade Roundup -LLOYDMINSTER EXHIBITION (16yrs-21yrs)</li> <li>2. Needs to be entered in the Junior Exhibitor Female Show.</li> <li>3. When the successful senior competitor applies, they must indicate on their intention to be enrolled in an agricultural related post- secondary program.</li> </ol>

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. The award shall be held in trust at <b>KRAMER AUCTIONS A RITCHIE BROS. SOLUTION</b> until the applicant enrolls in a course on or before 21 years of age.</li> <li>5. If the applicant has not enrolled in an approved course upon or before turning 21 years of age, the award will be returned to <b>KRAMER AUCTIONS A RITCHIE BROS. SOLUTION</b></li> </ol>
SELECTION CRITERIA	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The awarding of the scholarship is based on the first place competitor of the Showmanship class at Junior Female Exhibitor show at Stockade Roundup - Lloydminster Exhibition.</li> </ol>

The winner must complete the scholarship form upon competition of being placed 1<sup>st</sup> at the Junior Exhibitor Female show at Stockade Roundup.
