This question is a comparative one for pre and post program, so that students can judge if their beliefs have altered. Young people who enjoyed their last sexual experience were more likely to say they were in a relationship, felt ready and weren't pressured into it, both wanted sex; were able to talk to each other; had trust; felt safe. What is gender stereotyping?	<p>Correct answer refers to any one or more of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • preconceived ideas about how people should act based on whether they are male or female • over-simplified behaviour assigned to all men or all women based solely on gender <p>Incorrect answer refers to any one or more of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • content is correct but does not state the concept is preconceived or oversimplified (<i>'It's when girls play with dolls and boys play with trucks.'</i>) A correct version of this would be, <i>'(It's when people assume that all girls play with dolls and boys play with trucks.)'</i> • any other response that does not provide a reasonable explanation, is vague or disconnected from the question 	1
	Give one example of gender stereotyping that affects either males or females when it comes to relationships.	<p>Correct answer refers to any one or more of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • any response that clearly shows the explanation for a person's action has been based on their gender. Note: response may not be a stereotype you have heard of, but as long as it is clearly being blamed being a certain gender, then it is to be marked correct. <p>Incorrect answer refers to any one or more of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • any response that refers to biological reasons, (<i>'Women have to have the babies.'</i>) • any other response that does not provide a reasonable explanation, is vague or disconnected from the question 	1
