When Twenty Years Seems Like An Eternity by Pastor Schumacher

Next Sunday we celebrate 20 years at our present location on Modaff Road. In February of 1997, the members of Bethany marched from 919 Washington to 1550 Modaff Road and dedicated our new church and school building. Much has happened in the past 20 years. There have been milestones regarding our building. We paid off the mortgage early, added stained glass windows to the sanctuary, built a new music and youth wing, and expanded our Day School space. There have been special events like youth and school auctions, family reunions, Goofy Olympics, and two Oktoberfests. There have been fine concerts and thrilling volleyball and basketball games.

But the most important events of the last 20 years are the ones that will continue for the next 100 years! They are the events where we know the Lord's eternal promises. We are blessed with a special baptismal font where the water of the font goes into the pool on the other side of the font. Everytime we approach the altar we are reminded of our baptism, and most importantly, at our font, infants and adults have their sins washed away, as they are baptized into Christ's death and resurrection. In our

chancel, we have a beautiful altar with paraments that proclaim Christ. From that altar is distributed the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus, given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. Also in the chancel is the pulpit. We have been blessed over the past 20 years to have had five pastors (including the current two) proclaim faithfully Law and Gospel to the baptized at Bethany.

And we have the first pew on the pulpit side of the church. There have sat mourning families countless times. They have lost love ones, but from that pew they have heard the words of Jesus, "*I am the resurrection and the Life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die.*" John 11:25-26. At their time of loss, they have heard of eternal life in Jesus.

What matters most at Bethany is eternal life in Jesus. He has made us His people and has blessed us with our gorgeous facility. He has blessed us with each other and, most of all, He has blessed us with Himself. To Him to all glory, honor and praise.
