Holy Trinity and the Holy Ones by Pastor Schumacher

Today is Trinity Sunday. For some people, "Trinity Sunday" means "Oh, that's when we say that really long and confusing creed—the "Agnacious" or "Athenian" or something; Or "that's when we hear once again the teaching that Christians believe in One God—Three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit." While it is true that we do confess the Athanasian Creed on Trinity Sunday, and it is true that we recall that the one true God is the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, this day is not an academic exercise in doctrine. Rather it is a day to remember who our God is, what He has done for us, and that we are His people.

God is not just some fact. He is the Almighty One, the Creator of the Heavens and the Earth. We live in full view of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Trinity is holy, and so we are to be holy in His sight. The problem is that we are not holy; we are sinners. We do not match the holiness of the God who is everywhere. Being a sinner before holy God is fatal; it leads to eternal death. Many in our society basically ignore God and their sin. Others give lip service to God and their sin, but then lead their lives in the way they want to.

The Christian knows they are sinners; the Christian also knows that the Holy Trinity is the saving God. The Trinity wants us saved. God the Father sent the Son. God the Son became incarnate, and then died for sins, rose from the dead, and ascended in order to intercede for sinners. God the Holy Spirit creates and sustains faith in the hearts of sinners through the means of grace (Word and Sacraments). The Holy Trinity is the Holy Trinity for us!

Because of God the Son's atoning work, and God the Holy Spirit causing us to have faith in Christ, we now have forgiveness of sins. We are now pure; we are the Holy Ones. We are the Holy Ones who live with the name of the Holy Trinity on us in our baptism. We are no longer our own; we are His. Our lives are His. To believe in the Trinity is to cling to Him, trust in Him, and to live as His child. Rejoice, the Holy Trinity is for you and your salvation. Live in Him as His Holy Ones. Amen.
