Prayers: So Much Said, So Much to Say *by Pastor Schumacher*

I recently had to have some dental work done. Sitting in the dentist's chair, jaw numb from Novocain, mouth wide open with the dentist carefully doing his work, I took the opportunity to pray. Since I was going to be in the chair for a while, I prayed through salvation history. Beginning with the creation, I thought of the various stages of salvation history as presented in Holy Scriptures, and then I prayed to God about the various events. I thanked Him for His great works. I thought of how I had sinned like various people in the Bible, and asked the Lord for forgiveness. I marveled at the awesomeness of God's works. I rejoiced in God's grace that He planned out His work of salvation completely. The time in the chair went by much more quickly and pleasantly than if I was focusing on the drill and the sound of instruments scraping my teeth.

My prayer to the Lord that day was only possible as a response to God's gracious works. First of all, God created us, and has revealed Himself to us in His Word. His Word tells us of what He has done for us, and it tells of man's failures before God. It tells of God's ultimate work of salvation in Jesus Christ, and

how He will ultimately give us a glorious and eternal kingdom when Christ comes back. What God has done is God's work, and that we know of His work in Scripture is God's work. And it is God's work that we are believers. The whole work of salvation is God's work. Jesus has made full atonement for our sins, and the Holy Spirit has converted us by His work of bringing us to repentance and faith in Christ. True prayer can only be a response to what God has already done by His Word.

Please do not think that I am the best example of a prayer. Far from it. I am a sinner who needs Jesus, and I have Jesus. God has given me everything in Christ, and I look forward to the day when I see Jesus face to face. In the meantime, I have the Word; I know that God is always with me; and He has invited me to pray. So I will.

I write this account as an encouragement for you to pray. Be immersed in God's Word, and from His Word, speak back to Him. That is prayer. Know that you can use so many moments of the day to come to your Lord and speak to Him. He is with you. He will hear your prayer.
