Coram Deo—Before God By Pastor Schumacher

As we approach the 500th anniversary of the Reformation you might hear some Latin words: Sola Gratia, Sola Fide, Sola Scriptura. In English: Grace Alone, Faith Alone, Scripture Alone. These highlight central Lutheran tenets. We are saved by Grace Alone by Faith Alone in Jesus Christ Alone, and this we know by Scripture Alone. There's some other Latin words that are also very important, and in fact, they formed the underlying basis for Luther to consider the three Solas so important. These Latin words are "Coram Deo," which means "before God."

We are always before God. As *Psalm 139* and other passages declare, God is everywhere. You cannot avoid being in His presence any more than you avoid being cold when standing outside in Siberia in January, or being hot standing in the Sahara desert in July. You cannot avoid being before God. This being "Before God" is what drove Luther to despair before His rediscovery of the Gospel. He knew He was before God, and He was terrified of God knowing his sin, and judging him for it.

However Luther read Scripture, especially *Romans 1*, and understood that Christ's righteousness was imputed to him by faith, and now he was declared

righteous. Luther now rejoiced that he was saved by faith alone in Jesus, who paid the full price for his salvation. Now "Coram Deo" became a joy. Luther realized he was never out of the presence of Jesus, who saved him. Being before the God who saves became a comfort to Luther.

A constant temptation for us is to forget that we are always before God. This means that it is easy to think that our sins are not too bad, and it is easy to forget about God's presence throughout the day. We ignore God and His Word constantly. But since we are always "Coram Deo", this is foolish. Since we are before God, we need to see our sins as He sees them, and repent of them, and believe in Jesus.

Your sins are forgiven in Jesus. You can live every day in His presence rejoicing in it. In Jesus, God is **for** you, and God is **with** you. Rejoice in His presence. Your prayers will be heard as He is with you. You are "Coram Deo"--before your Savior Jesus, now and forever. So you too can rejoice with Luther that you are saved by Grace Alone through Faith Alone, and you know this by Scripture Alone. Jesus is with you always (*Matt. 28:20*).
