

Instructions Choose 6 fabrics: white, grey, black, and a light, medium, and dark of a color group. This block is based on a traditional 9 patch. All Seam allowances are 1/4"

Cutting Instructions

for one 12 1/2" block (12" finished)


-  Fabric A (White): Cut 1 Square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
-  Fabric B (Grey): Cut 2 Squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
-  Fabric C (Black): Cut 1 Square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
-  Fabric D (Lt Blue): Cut 2 Squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
-  Fabric E (Med. Blue): Cut 2 Squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
-  Fabric F (Dr. Blue): Cut 2 Squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Cutting Instructions

for 4 blocks *One 24" section of the Bespoke BOM


-  Fabric A (White): Cut 1 strip 4 1/2" x 18"
-  Fabric B (Grey): Cut 2 strips 4 1/2" x 18"
-  Fabric C (Black): Cut 1 strip 4 1/2" x 18"
-  Fabric D (Lt Blue): Cut 2 strips 4 1/2" x 18"
-  Fabric E (Med. Blue): Cut 2 strips 4 1/2" x 18"
-  Fabric F (Dr. Blue): Cut 2 strips 4 1/2" x 18"

Piece a single 12" Block: Assemble the 4 1/2" squares as illustrated




1. Sew the 4 1/2" squares together as shown.
2. Press to nest your seams.
1st row press away from center
2nd row press toward center
3rd row press away from center
3. Stitch the rows together to create your block!

Strip-piece 4 blocks at a time for a 24" Bespoke BOM section



Subcut four sections, 4 1/2" each, from each strip set.



Sew the strip sets together as shown. Make 4 blocks total. Stitch the four blocks together to create one 24" section of the Bespoke BOM.

Variation! Same idea, different size pieces! Choose 6 fabrics: white, grey, black, and a light, medium, and dark of a color group. This block is also a 9 patch. All Seam allowances are 1/4"

Cutting Instructions


for one 12 1/2" block (12" finished)

-  Fabric A (White): Cut 1 Square 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
-  Fabric B (Grey): Cut 2 Strips 2 1/2" x 8 1/2"
-  Fabric C (Black): Cut 1 Square 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"
-  Fabric D (Lt Blue): Cut 2 Squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
-  Fabric E (Med. Blue): Cut 1 Square 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
-  Fabric F (Dk. Blue): Cut 2 Strips 2 1/2" x 8 1/2"


Cutting Instructions

for 4 blocks *One 24" section of the Bespoke BOM

-  Fabric A (White): Cut 1 strip 2 1/2" x 10"
-  Fabric B (Grey): Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" x 34"
-  Fabric C (Black): Cut 4 Squares, 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" each
-  Fabric D (Lt Blue): Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" x 10"
-  Fabric E (Med. Blue): Cut 1 strip 2 1/2" x 10"
-  Fabric F (Dk. Blue): Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" x 34"




Piece a single 12" Block: Assemble the 4 1/2" squares as illustrated



1. Sew the pieces together as shown.

2. Stitch the rows together to create your block!


Strip-piece 4 blocks at a time for a 24" Bespoke BOM section



Stitch two B-F strip sets 34" long. Subcut into 8 pieces (4 pieces for each set, 8 1/2" long each)


Stitch one D-E strip sets and one A-D strip set and subcut each into 4 pieces 2 1/2" each.

Cut 4 squares 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"






Sew the strip sets together as shown. Make 4 blocks total. Stitch the four blocks together to create one 24" section of the Bespoke BOM.

PMQG 2018 BOM Assemble 4 blocks for a 24" square



Make a 48" x 60" lap or baby quilt with 20 blocks (4 x 5)
Make a 72" x 84" twin or throw quilt with 42 blocks (6 x 7)
