





**Instructions** Choose 4 fabrics: white, grey, black, and a color.  
This block uses strip piecing and is built as a four patch. All Seam allowances are 1/4"





**Cutting Instructions**

for one 12½" block (12" finished)  
*\*Tip: I typically cut my strips 1/2" longer and trim.  
The measurements below do not reflect this.*

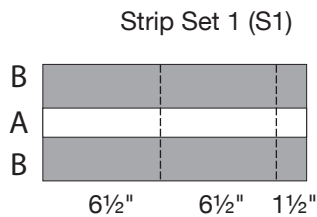
-  Fabric A (White): Cut 1 strip 1½" x 14½"
-  Fabric B (Grey): Cut 2 strips 3" x 14½"  
Cut 1 strip 1½" x 6"
-  Fabric C (Black): Cut 2 strips 3" x 6"
-  Fabric D (Yellow): Cut 1 Square 6½" x 6½"

**Cutting Instructions**

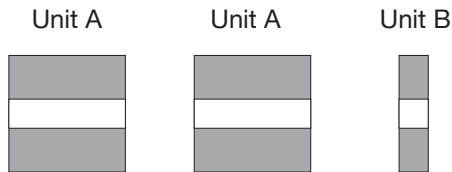
for 4 blocks \*One 24" section of the Bespoke BOM  
*\*Note: combine strips into longer pieces for quick assembly*

-  Fabric A (White): Cut 2 strips 1½" x 29"
-  Fabric B (Grey): Cut 4 strips 3" x 29"  
Cut 1 strip 1½" x 24"
-  Fabric C (Black): Cut 4 strips 3" x 24"
-  Fabric D (Yellow): Cut 4 Squares 6½" x 6½" (or 1 strip 6½" x26" and subcut)

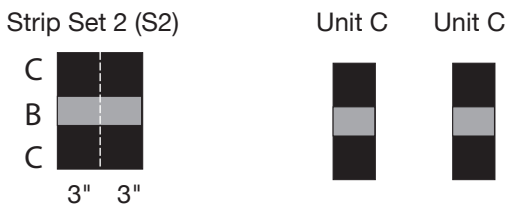
**Piece a single 12" Block**



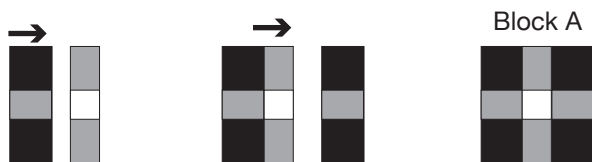
1. Stitch the Fabric A strip to the Fabric B strips. Press.



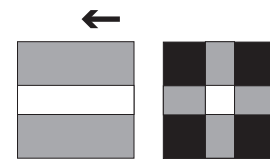
2. Subcut S1 into (2) 6½" x 6½" squares (Unit A) and (1) 1½" x 6½" strip (Unit B).



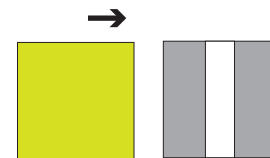
3. Stitch the Fabric C strips to the Fabric B strip. Press.  
4. Subcut into (2) 2½" x 6½" strips (Unit C).



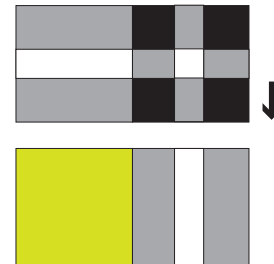
5. Stitch a Unit C section to Unit B.  
6. Stitch the other Unit C to the other side of Units C/B



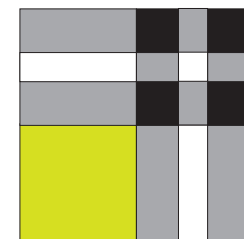
7. Stitch a Unit A piece to Block A



8. Stitch the Fabric D square to a Unit A piece

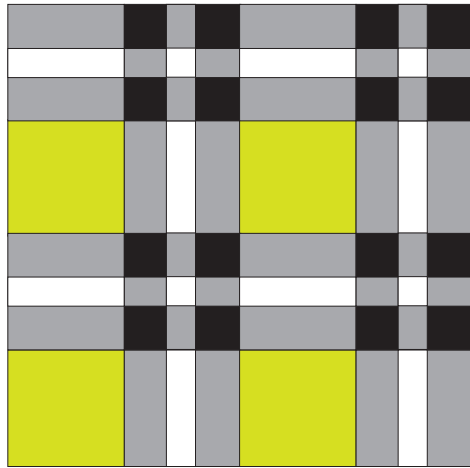


9. Stitch the Unit A/Block A section to the D Square/Unit A section.

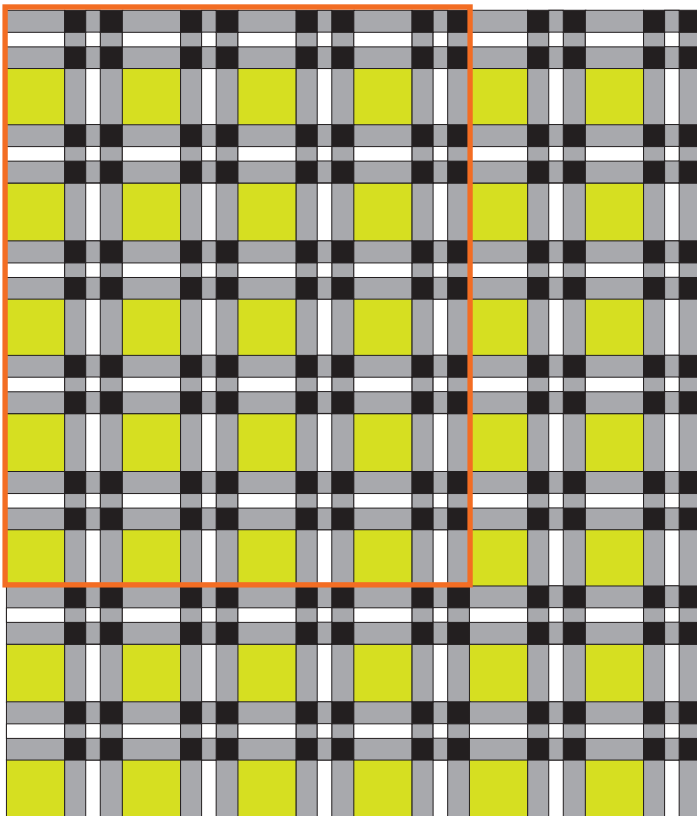


10. Press and square-up!

\*Make 4 blocks for the April section of the PMQG Bespoke BOM.







Make a 48" x 60" lap quilt with 20 blocks (4 x 5)  
 Make a 72" x 84" twin/throw quilt with 42 blocks (6 x 7)

**Try this variation:**

Make the same block using three colors instead of four. Combine Fabric A and Fabric D: this eliminates the white. Fabric B becomes a shade that is inbetween A/B and C

-  Fabric A (was White): Cut 1 strip 1 1/2" x 14 1/2"
-  Fabric D (was Yellow): Cut 1 Square 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"
-  Fabric B (was Grey): Cut 2 strips 3" x 14 1/2"  
Cut 1 strip 1 1/2" x 6"
-  Fabric C (Black): Cut 2 strips 3" x 6"
