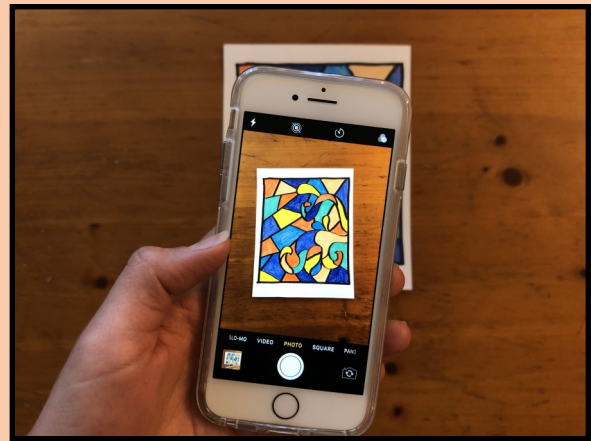


## Make A Stained-Glass Window Puzzle



Step 1:

Use a permanent marker and colored pencils, crayons, or markers to draw a window design on paper or card.



Step 2:

Take a photo of your design to help you when you're putting your puzzle back together.



Step 3:

Using scissors, carefully cut your design along the black lines. Ask for a grownup to help you if needed.



Step 4:

Mix up your pieces, and then try to complete your puzzle! Use the photo you took as a guide. When you're done, challenge someone else to complete it!
