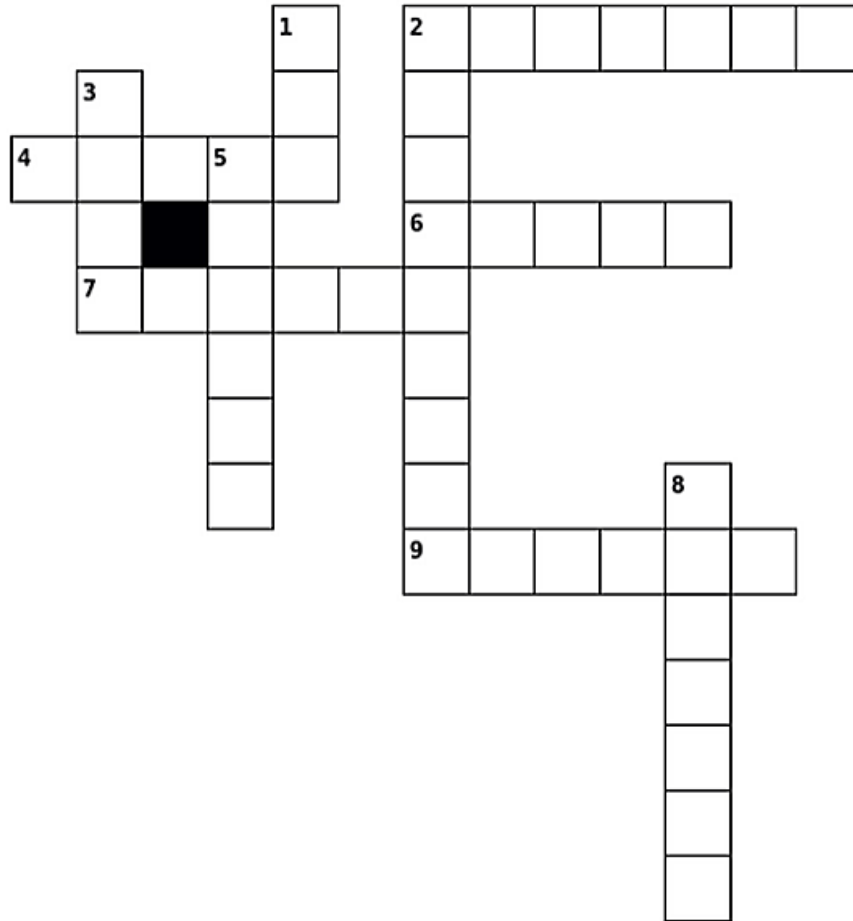

- 2. A goddess who is part hippopotamus, crocodile, and lion
- 4. This type of flower was seen as a symbol of rebirth and regeneration
- 6. The Egyptian word for this was "ib"
- 7. A type of adornment worn on the head
- 9. This type of beetle was often used as an amulet

## Down

- 1. This god is often shown wearing a feathered headdress and holding knives
- 2. This pharaoh was known as "Good God, Lord of the Two Lands"
- 3. One of the metals used to make pieces of jewelry on display
- 5. A rearing cobra
- 8. A material made of crushed quartz, alkaline slats, lime, and colorants
