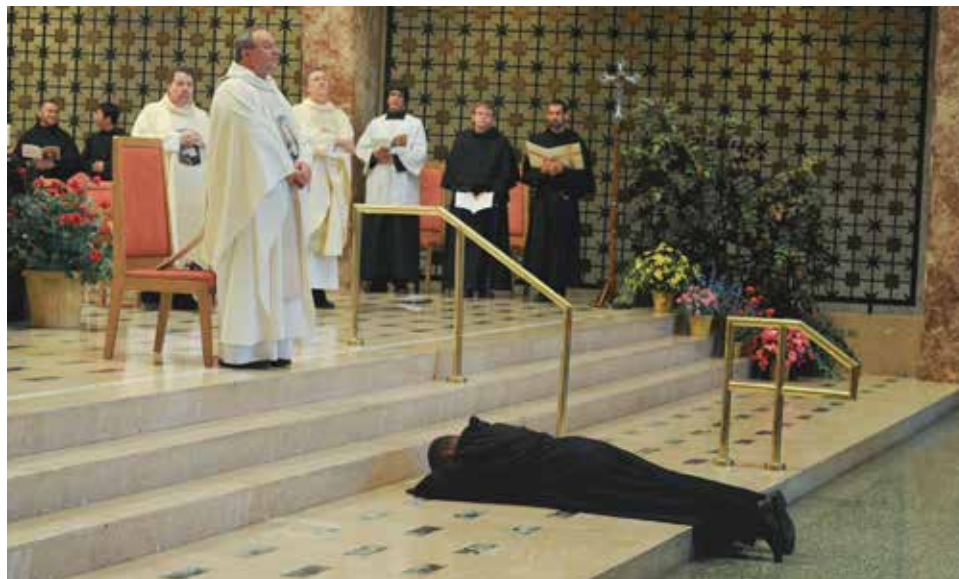

Jesus said "I came that you may have life, and have it abundantly" (John 10:10). Life is God's greatest gift to us, and for the Augustinian Family, we recognize an important sign of life in those men who have decided to join us and to give their lives to serve others. The future of the Order depends upon those who come to join us as we look for ways of continuing our mission in the Church.

Pope Francis, in *The Joy of the Gospel*, writes: "Young people call us to renewed and expansive hope, for they represent new directions for humanity and open us up to the future..." (n. 108). This year, the Augustinians in the Midwest Province, along with the Provinces of California and Villanova, can celebrate that we too have been called to renew our sense of hope, as we have continued to be blessed with new vocations who are not only a source of joy for all of us, but are also a reminder that we are called to share our charism as builders of community and faith-filled communion in a world that is frequently afflicted with division and hatred.

The numbers are of course significant, although they in themselves never tell the whole story. Our vocations

office continues to receive numerous inquiries, and from those, after a time to get to know one another, we receive our candidates into the pre-novitiate program. Most of the pre-novices spend one or two years in Ardmore, Pennsylvania, while doing academic work (philosophy and theology) at Villanova University. This year, the pre-novices numbered six; two new candidates from the Midwest Province have joined the Ardmore community this year.

From the pre-novitiate, the candidates go to the novitiate in Racine, Wisconsin. In August of this year, nine men have concluded the novitiate in Racine. They come from various Provinces of the Augustinian Order, including all three of the U.S. Provinces, Great Britain, and Poland. While some have returned to their home provinces for further preparation, six of these novices, after making their first profession of vows as Augustinians, moved on to the next level of formation that takes place at St. Augustine Friary in Chicago.

St. Augustine Friary is the professed house of formation for the North American Provinces of the Order. This year, there are ten men in temporary vows living in the community. The professed students at St. Augustine's ordinarily pursue some kind of academic degree, most of them at Catholic Theological Union, in fulfillment of the requirements that the Church indicates for those preparing for ordination to the priesthood. There are also men who are called to be brothers in the Order, rather than to ordained ministry. They, too, are in formation in order to develop themselves intellectually and spiritually for service in the Order, whether as teachers or counselors or in other forms of ministry.

Besides the professed at St. Augustine Friary, there are six other simply professed friars who are working or studying in different communities of

the Order. Most of these are doing what we call a "pastoral year" (a kind of "internship" that gives them direct experience of some aspects of Augustinian ministry in one or more areas of service in the Church, such as teaching, parish work, etc.).

In May of this year, Fr. Rich Young, O.S.A., who came to the Order after his ordination to priesthood, made his solemn profession in the Order. In addition, there are several other priests at the various levels of formation: there is one priest in simple vows; a priest for the Polish Province has concluded his novitiate and will soon profess; and two priests are in the pre-novitiate time of discernment.

It is well known that in the Western world the numbers of vocations have diminished in recent years. And yet it is interesting to take note of something

Pope Francis said in *The Joy of the Gospel*: "Wherever there is life, fervor and a desire to bring Christ to others, genuine vocations will arise." The Augustinians in the United States have been blessed with an increasing number of vocations during these past several years. The call to give one's life totally to service in the Church, following Christ in the Augustinian Family, is being heard, and people are responding. The lay men and women who are part of the Augustinian family, who support us in many different ways, are also important as together we look for ways of meeting up to the challenge expressed by Pope Francis: of promoting "life, fervor and a desire to bring Christ to others." Our prayer will continue as we work together to promote vocations and to provide the best formation for the Augustinians of tomorrow. And we are deeply grateful for the financial support that enables us to prepare our candidates for their lives of service.

## Care for Retired and Infirm Augustinians

Our ministry of health care continues to change and provides graced opportunities for all those involved. One change that is constant is an increase of friars entering into our health care program at St. Anthony's Home in Crown Point, Indiana. In the past several months, five

friars have joined us for needed services. They are: Fr. Henry Maibusch, O.S.A., Fr. Ed Kersten, O.S.A., Bro. John Stobba, O.S.A., Br. David Adelsbach, O.S.A., and Bro. Bob Schurman, O.S.A. The first three are in assisted living, and the last two are in skilled care. Bro. David is slowly healing from a serious

infection and within the next few months hopefully will no longer need care at St. Anthony's. Bro. Angelo Sturn, O.S.A., remains in assisted living and Fr. John Flaherty, O.S.A., in skilled care. Fr. Dan Hartigan, O.S.A., the last friar at Franciscan Village in Lemont, has recently moved to Mercy Circle in Chicago;

while all the others above are at St. Anthony's in Crown Point. The doctors and professional staff at both facilities continue to serve our friars' needs very well and with great care for each man.

One area of our health care that needs to be highlighted is the central role of our community life. Prayer life together and care flow out into a new arena for ministry by both the caregivers and those needing care. The community schedule for the friars at Blessed Stephen Bellesini engages all the friars with a common schedule that gives life to their vowed commitment. Most are mobile and gather each morning for Mass and Divine Office. At noon they all gather for the main meal in the assisted living dining room. At 3:30 p.m., they go over to the friary (where the caregivers live) for community recreation and end with

evening prayer in the friary chapel. At 5 p.m., they return to assisted living for the evening meal or on many occasions will stay and share an evening meal at the friary.

This is the framework for the common life, and most of it is done in the public forum of all the residents at St. Anthony's. This interaction within the larger community of residents allows our men to share themselves in many different ways. I, as well as many others, have heard and seen our men speaking with people who want to listen and

friars listening to people who need to speak. This exchange and impact of their PRESENCE has and does speak volumes about our Augustinian charism and way of life. Our men who came to receive care, give care over and over again. It is not just the caregivers for the friars who have a ministry of care, but also those who can be one with the aging, sick, and weak. These are the memories experienced by residents of our friars at Bl. Stephen Bellesini Friary.

For example, one day at the noon meal, the lady bringing us our food heard us

laughing, as they all do, and she said to me, "You're always laughing. In my house we never laughed! Thank you." Ministry in action through PRESENCE!

Ten men living at Bl. Stephen Bellesini Friary represent 479 years of religious life and ministry. At this time of their life, they are not through yet! Our mission lives. We thank all our benefactors and friends for your prayers and support. God has blessed us with you; know that we all pray for God's continued grace in your lives. We need you now more than ever.

### Missions in Peru

This year, the Augustinians have celebrated 50 years of presence in the Diocese of Chulucanas, being among the poor, and responding to the call of the Church. As Pope Francis says, "Be a poor Church for the poor." This is what has always driven our brothers of the Province of Our Mother of Good Counsel in Chicago and the Province of St. Thomas of Villanova in Pennsylvania who sent missionaries to Peru in 1964. So with great joy and gratitude to God, we have celebrated under the theme entitled, "We celebrate and renew our journey of faith." Bishop John McNabb, O.S.A., was also with us during our celebration. With him, we began our journey of faith, similar to the title of his book, *Led Where I Did Not Plan to Go*. During these concluding celebrations, the Papal Nuncio to Peru joined many bishops from other parts of Peru to accompany and celebrate with our beloved leader, Bishop Daniel Turley, O.S.A., and the local Church. There were many events that the diocese's 22

parishes prepared in order to remember and celebrate this journey of faith.

Now I would like to thank all of my brothers and sisters of this missionary vicariate in Peru, and more specifically, all the benefactors who so generously support this mission to bring about the Kingdom of God. God will reward your Christian gesture!

Promoting vocations has become more difficult, but nevertheless, young people want to continue preparing for the religious life. We have in our vicariate Fr. Gioberty Calle, O.S.A., as the coordinator responsible in this area. This year in the formation house we have 14 men, and in the house of the professed we have 15 more.

There are also two brothers here from Ecuador and three men in their pastoral year in our parishes. To run the seminary and care for the education and board of each Peruvian in Augustinian formation, it costs \$650 per month and \$7,800 per year.

Also, this year the Archbishop of Trujillo elevated

St. Rita Chapel to the status of a parish; the first pastor is our Fr. Alberto Saavedra, O.S.A. The formation community utilizes this apostolate to help prepare our men in formation.

At our St. Augustine School in Trujillo, 16 children entered their first year. Fr. Ramiro was named as the director of this educational institution. An architect and his wife are helping us make plans for the new school and we hope to have them start building soon. With faith, we believe in the providence of God and the help of our supporters to be able to start as soon as we can

build some classrooms to develop this new building in a couple of years.

In thinking about the construction progress, and at the suggestion of the Augustinian Curia in Rome, we have appointed full-time friars to the school project, including Fr. Eleodoro Villanueva, O.S.A. Hopefully we will be able to find donors so that we can construct it very well. We are presently very grateful to those that have collaborated with us thus far so that the project has taken shape; the school is a hope for our vicariate's mission among service to the poor.

In Pacaipampa, the poorest parish in the Diocese of Chulucanas, it has been four years since we began St. Rita Dining Hall so that parents can send their children to school. The parents live in very remote and impoverished areas and would not otherwise send

their children to school. Thanks to God and to the Augustinian community working in Pacaipampa, the program is working; still, we need \$4,500 a year to support the 50 children taking advantage of the program. I know that there are donors that support us Augustinians, but this has been an opportunity to help the locals by reducing hunger, creating better conditions, and long-term community development for our needy brothers and sisters in Christ.

In Chulucanas at San José Obrero Parish, we have had a project to help those infected with HIV and those with AIDS, but due to the economic conditions, we could not continue this support this past year at the same level we had. Although the government provides some medicines, the parish helped with food and other necessities

for these people. We want to continue this project since it responds to the cry of those who have no one else to turn to, so that they may live with dignity.

We also celebrate and thank God for the 50 years of presence in Morropón. On August 23 and 24, we celebrated with the youth of our parishes, thus formalizing our new youth ministry program, as well as the solemn profession of Brother Yhony Castillo, O.S.A.

In September, we will also have our Vicariate Chapter in the pastoral center of Chulucanas with the presence of our Prior Provincial, the Very Rev. Bernard C. Scianna, O.S.A., Ph.D., who will come to join us and move forward with us, representing unity from everyone of the Midwest Augustinian Province.

# Augustinian Education

These difficult economic times have made it a significant challenge to continue to offer Catholic education to the next generation of young people. All five Augustinian high schools of the Midwest and Canada are doing everything they can to provide financial aid to families with financial needs. Generally speaking, schools insist that parents apply online using a financial aid form which sets a baseline against which the schools can determine a family's level of need and the schools ability to meet that need. Only a certain percentage of need is met: for example, at Providence Catholic of New Lenox, Illinois, about 40% of family need-based aid is met. Other schools have similar stories and can relate individual and anecdotal examples where they have had to go beyond their ordinary sources of income to help provide

aid to keep students in our schools.

School leadership meets twice a year around the Province to assess where we are, encourage each other in our work, and make plans for the future. Villanova College in King City, Ontario, is directed by Head of School, Mr. Paul Paradiso, who founded the school and is assisted by lay people. This school is on the Augustinian property of Marylake Friary in King City. Our partnership with our brothers and sisters in Canada has been very fruitful. Villanova College graduates students well prepared for the university experience. The school has a beautiful campus about thirty miles outside of Toronto.

St. Rita of Cascia High School, like all the rest of us, is engaged in looking

for ways to increase enrollment and to prepare for its long range future. They have recently built the McCarthy Student Center and have completed a project to totally renovate and modernize the library. Modern libraries are now called learning commons and are somewhat different than the traditional model.

Providence Catholic High School in New Lenox, Illinois, has hired Dr. John

Harper to be its next Principal. Dr. Harper is a thirty-three year veteran of public education in Plainfield, Illinois, and is a Providence Catholic graduate. Three of Dr. Harper's children will be attending Providence Catholic this fall and we look forward to his infusion of new ideas and insights.

Austin Catholic High School in Ray, Michigan, has worked hard to increase its enrollment and is receiving more attention in the area. It resides northeast of Detroit, Michigan, in a somewhat rural area and is the

only Catholic high school there. The people at Austin are very welcoming and friendly and very much enjoy participating in the Augustinian spirit and charism.

Cascia Hall School in Tulsa, Oklahoma, is operated by its lay Headmaster, Mr. Roger Carter, ably assisted by Director of Augustinian Mission Fr. Brian Barker, O.S.A., and several competent and qualified lay people. Cascia Hall provides a top quality education in the state of Oklahoma which is very small in its

percentage of Catholics. Cascia Hall has recently completed renovation on its wrestling facilities and presents a beautiful campus just about ten minutes southeast of downtown Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Our schools provide a quality education in the Augustinian tradition to young people who are preparing for college and life after college. Please pray for our schools, and if you are able, help us with your financial support.

## Parish Ministry

The Augustinian Friars of the Midwest Province maintain a pastoral presence in Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin and in Canada. Our friars serve five parishes in Illinois, this includes the Chicago Archdiocese and the Joliet Diocese. In Michigan, we are represented in Flint (Lansing Diocese) and in Edwardsburg (Kalamazoo Diocese). In the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, friars serve in Racine. We also offer our pastoral care in Delta, British Columbia (Vancouver Archdiocese), and in King City, Ontario (Toronto Archdiocese).

As of last June 2013, we left our ministry at St. Peter Parish in Douglas, Michigan, due to health issues of the last Augustinian pastor. Currently, we have approximately 20 friars full-time, part-time/semi-retired active in parochial ministry. This number can be fluid at times due to the move from full-time ministry to senior status.

The parishes we serve are representative of combined populations of middle and lower income households. The diversity in race, culture and ethnicity are basically found in the parishes in the Chicago area. Many of our parishes have existing and developing programs that address the social needs of the

local population. More specifically, the Chicago parishes devote time and energy to the inner-city issues that affect the respective communities such as housing, safety, immigration, and education.

There is a lot of energy developing in collaborative relationships between our parishes and local community organizations and agencies addressing the issues listed above. Multi-lingual (English, Spanish, and Polish) communities continue to grow especially in the Chicago area. This calls for more intentional and deliberate consultation and decision-making on the part of the Pastors' Forum and the Province overall regarding how the Augustinians continue contributing our pastoral service to the diverse needs in the Chicago Archdiocese. Attracting Hispanic vocations is becoming more of a priority, seeing that the numbers of the Catholic population in the U.S. Church are increasing, especially in the Chicago area.

Presently, our parish priests continue to age and will be facing at least semi-retirement as the years progress. However, our recently ordained friars offer a newer energy presently in our parish commitments. Other young men in formation have expressed exploring pastoral ministry in our parishes as they move on toward committing themselves to the Order.

Offering ourselves to pastoral service without being in administrative positions requires further exploration and reflection among the friars in parochial ministry.

Currently, we have healthy parish ministries with dedicated and committed friars who offer their pastoral skills for the good of the Church.

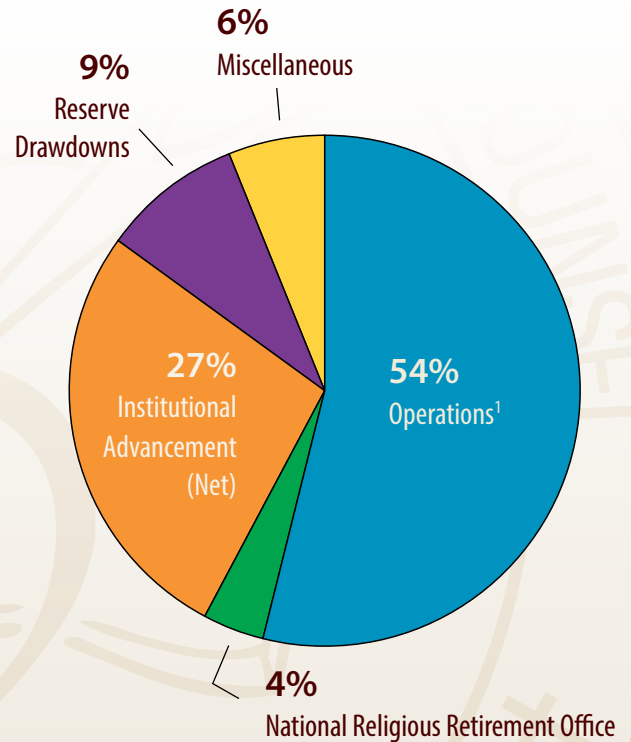

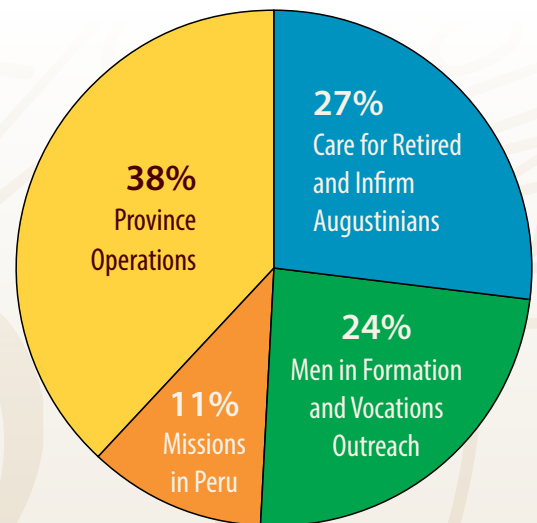

## THE GOOD NEWS BEHIND THE NUMBERS

Our stewardship and financial situation have improved significantly since 2011. They continue to improve. Here are some trends worth noting. The past three years:

- Vocations expenses have more than doubled due to a stronger vocations outreach effort,
- Formation expenses have more than doubled because we have many more men in studies,
- Fundraising revenues are up more than 30% and increasing,
- There are \$1.9 million in new fundraising pledges not reflected in the figures above, and
- We are drawing far less from our trusts thereby allowing the principal to grow which was not the case ten years prior to this period.

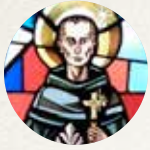
