

## **Charles W. Garver Scholarship Application** **Fall 2016 - Spring 2017**

The Charles W. Garver Educational Fund was established in honor of the 1954 pledge class. Beginning in 2013, the Fund has offered a \$1,000 scholarship every year to a Kansas Alpha member for their outstanding contribution to the fraternity.

### **Requirements:**

- Full-time (12 or more credit hours) undergraduate attending the University of Kansas.
- Active member in good standing of the Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity, Kansas Alpha Chapter, who has lived in the chapter house the entire school year (for example - for a member to receive a scholarship for the Fall 2015/Spring 2016 school year, they would have to have lived in the chapter house for both the Fall 2015 and Spring 2016 semesters).
