FLC TASK FORCE: PURPOSE

GENERAL PURPOSE OF THE TASK FORCE:

• TO RESEARCH UPCOMING CHANGES IN THE GOVERNANCE AND CONSTITUTIONAL LANGUAGE OF THE ELCA AND HOW IT MAY AFFECT FLC.

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- MEMBERS OF THE TASK FORCE: MICAH ABERSON, SHAD CARNEY, JOHN HEGG, DEB NELSON, MARILYN VANDEMARK, MASON VAN ESSEN, BARNEY BRANDENBURG

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- 1) TO REVIEW THE CURRENT RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE ELCA AND FLC.
- 2) TO ASSESS WHAT HAS CHANGED IN THAT RELATIONSHIP.
- 3) TO CONSIDER WHETHER IT IS STILL IN THE BEST INTEREST OF FLC TO CONTINUE THE RELATIONSHIP WITH THE ELCA.

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- 6) TO REVIEW OTHER PERTINENT DOCUMENTS AND VIDEOS DISCOVERED THROUGH OUR INVESTIGATIVE PROCESS.
- 7) WE ALSO CONDUCTED INTERVIEWS AND VIEWED A WEBINAR WITH BISHOP HAGMAIER.

QUESTIONS TO ANSWER

AS A TASK FORCE, WE FELT THERE WERE A SERIES OF QUESTIONS THAT WERE IMPORTANT TO ANSWER IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE OUR GOALS

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 - WHEN A CONTRACT (CONSTITUTION) IS AMENDED, IT SHOULD REQUIRE THE AGREEMENT OF ALL THE INVOLVED PARTIES.

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THE ELCA CONSTITUTION

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 - FLC CONSTITUTION WAS LAST AMENDED IN 2017.

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- •THIS IS INDICATIVE OF THE DESIRE FOR THE ELCA TO CONTROL THE LOCAL CONGREGATIONS IN A HIERARCHICAL FASHION.
- •IF WE DON'T CONTROL THE MAJOR ELEMENTS OF OUR CONSTITUTION, WE DON'T CONTROL OUR <u>PURPOSE</u> OR OUR FUTURE.

HOW IS THE ELCA CONSTITUTION CURRENTLY AMENDED?

2 METHODS

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METHOD 1: 6 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE CW ASSEMBLY, THE CW COUNCIL CAN OFFER AN AMENDMENT. IT IS SENT TO THE SYNODS FOR "DISCUSSION." AFTER CONVERSATION, IT GOES TO THE CW ASSEMBLY. IF IT PASSES BY 2/3 MAJORITY, IT IS ADOPTED.

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QUESTION: WHEN WAS THE LAST TIME OUR CONGREGATION WAS INVOLVED IN "DISCUSSION" ABOUT AMENDING THE ELCA CONSTITUTION?

HOW IS THE ELCA CONSTITUTION CURRENTLY AMENDED (2 METHODS)?

METHOD 2: AT THE CW ASSEMBLY, 25 MEMBERS CAN BRING A "FLOOR" AMENDMENT TO THE BODY. IT IS SENT FOR COMMITTEE REVIEW FOR APPROPRIATENESS. IT IS VOTED ON WHEN IT IS DEEMED APPROPRIATE AND PASSED BY A 2/3 MAJORITY. <u>IT THEN GOES BACK TO THE CONGREGATIONS FOR 3 YEARS FOR FEEDBACK.</u> IT RETURNS TO THE CW ASSEMBLY AND IF PASSED BY A 2/3 MAJORITY AGAIN, IT IS ADOPTED.

•SUGGESTED PROPOSAL: A FLOOR AMENDMENT CAN BE BROUGHT BY 25 MEMBERS OF THE CWA. IT IS REVIEWED BY A COMMITTEE, AND IF VALIDATED, IT IS VOTED ON BY THE ASSEMBLY. IF A FLOOR AMENDMENT PASSES BY 2/3 MAJORITY, IT MAY GO TO THE CONGREGATIONS AND BACK TO THE CW ASSEMBLY IN 3 YEARS,

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- THIS "FAST TRACK" PROPOSAL DID NOT PASS AT THE RECENT CHURCHWIDE ASSEMBLY DESPITE THE ENDORSEMENT OF THE CW COUNCIL, AND THE CRLC. (49.4% IN FAVOR, 50.6% OPPOSED)

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- WHILE THIS SUGGESTED PROPOSAL DID NOT PASS AT THE CWA THIS YEAR, THE PROCESS ITSELF IS TELLING FOR THE STANCE OF THE CW COUNCIL.

• DURING THE DEBATE ON THE FLOOR FOR THE AMENDMENT PROCESS, IT WAS CLEAR THAT THOSE IN FAVOR OF FAST TRACKING IT FELT THAT THEY WANTED THE ELCA TO MOVE MORE QUICKLY TO ADVANCE THEIR AGENDA.

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- THERE WAS OBVIOUS FRUSTRATION WHEN THE SUGGESTED AMENDMENT FAILED TO ADVANCE BY JUST 7 VOTES (746 OF THE 803 DELEGATES VOTED)
- THE CRLC CO-CHAIRMAN STRONGLY ENCOURAGED THAT THE ASSEMBLY "GET THIS DONE THIS YEAR."

• AS A RESULT, <u>A SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT</u> WAS PROPOSED.

• <u>THE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT</u> IS AS FOLLOWS: "A FLOOR AMENDMENT CAN BE BROUGHT BY 25 MEMBERS OF THE CWA. IT IS SENT FOR REVIEW BY THE REFERENCE AND COUNCIL COMMITTEE. IF VALIDATED, IT IS VOTED ON BY THE CWA. IF IT PASSES, IT MAY GO BACK TO THE NEXT CWA IN 3 YEARS TO BE VOTED ON UNCHANGED TO BE RATIFIED.

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- OR THE AMENDMENT MAY BE PROVISIONALLY EFFECTIVE BY A 2/3 VOTE OF THE CW COUNCIL TAKEN WITHIN 12 MONTHS OF ADOPTION BY THE CWA. THE PROVISIONAL STATUS WILL BE REMOVED ONLY BY RATIFICATION OF THE AMENDMENT BY THE CWA IN 3 YEARS. IF THE CWA FAILS TO RATIFY, THE PROVISIONAL EFFECTIVE STATUS OF THE AMENDMENT SHALL BE REVOKED.

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- RESULT: THE DELEGATES VOTED TO REFER IT BACK TO THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF THE CW COUNCIL.
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- THE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT WOULD GIVE THE CW COUNCIL THE AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT THE AMENDMENT IN THE 3 YEARS BETWEEN ASSEMBLIES (BEFORE RATIFICATION AT THE NEXT CW ASSEMBLY).

RAMIFICATIONS?

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- THAT MEMORIAL WAS WAS REFERRED BACK TO THE "TASK FORCE ON INTERDEPENDENCE AND PURPOSE" AND IS TO BE VOTED ON IN 2028.

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- •PRIOR TO THE CHURCHWIDE ASSEMBLY, THE CONGREGATION DID NOT HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THEIR CONSTITUTION.

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- •PRIOR TO THE CHURCHWIDE ASSEMBLY, THE CONGREGATION DID NOT HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THEIR CONSTITUTION.
- AFTER THE 2025 CW ASSEMBLY, THERE IS OBVIOUS MOVEMENT TOWARD EVEN LESS CONTROL WITH TASK FORCES IN PLACE TO MAKE CHANGES FOR CONGREGATIONS.

THIS IS A CONFIRMATION OF THE ELCA'S SHIFT FROM A CONGREGATIONAL BASED STRUCTURE TO ONE OF INSTITUTIONAL HIERARCHY.

QUESTIONS THE TASK FORCE SOUGHT TO ANSWER

- 1) DO WE BELIEVE WE SHOULD BE GOVERNED LOCALLY AND NOT BY A CENTRAL AUTHORITY, MEANING WE SHOULD BE ALLOWED TO HAVE FULL CONTROL OF WHAT IS IN THE FLC CONSTITUTION?
- 2) DO WE BELIEVE WE SHOULD HAVE FULL CONTROL OF OUR ASSETS AND PROPERTY?
- 3) DO WE BELIEVE WE SHOULD BE RESPECTED AND ALLOWED TO INDIVIDUALLY HOLD OUR OWN PERSONAL VIEWS ON SOCIAL AND POLITICAL MATTERS, AND THAT PREACHING OF CONTROVERSIAL VIEWS NOT BE MANDATED?

• THE FLC AND ELCA CONSTITUTIONS SAY THE CONGREGATION HAS SOLE AUTHORITY OF ITS PROPERTY AND ASSETS.

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• BUT, THE ELCA CONSTITUTION HAS AN EXCEPTION CLAUSE: S-13.24(D). (THIS IS IN THE SYNOD SECTION OF THE ELCA MODEL CONSTITUTION.)

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- THE CLAUSE ABOUT "PURPOSE" WAS ADDED IN 2019.

- "THE SYNOD MAY TAKE CONTROL IF THE CONGREGATION IS DEEMED THAT IT CANNOT FULFILL THE <u>PURPOSE</u> FOR WHICH IT WAS ORGANIZED."
- THIS CLAUSE MAY TRIGGER "SYNODICAL ADMINISTRATION" WHICH HAS ACTUALLY HAPPENED TO SEVERAL ELCA CONGREGATIONS AROUND THE COUNTRY.

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- IN SYNODICAL ADMINISTRATION, THE SYNOD COUNCIL ASSUMES CONTROL OF A CONGREGATION'S GOVERNANCE AND ASSETS.

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- THIS CLAUSE HAS BEEN ENFORCED BY SEVERAL SYNODS ACROSS THE COUNTRY REQUIRING LITIGATION.
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- •AFTER THE 2025 CHURCHWIDE ASSEMBLY, THERE IS <u>STILL A RISK</u> TO CONTROL OF OUR PROPERTY AND ASSETS FROM S13.24(D).

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• CONVERSATION FOLLOWING A BIBLE STUDY IN 2022 ABOUT ACTIONS OF THE ELCA AFTER THE CHURCHWIDE ASSEMBLY.

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 - WE HAVE A RICH HERITAGE OF THINKING INDEPENDENTLY: SIOUX VALLEY HOSPITAL, LSS, THE BANQUET, ST FRANCIS HOUSE, OTHERS.

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 - THE FLC CONSTITUTION STATES IN 9.09.01 "THE SENIOR PASTOR IS EXPECTED TO PROVIDE THE CONGREGATION WITH VISION, GUIDANCE FOR LONG RANGE GOALS, POLICIES AND OBJECTIVES..."

• AT THE 2025 CW ASSEMBLY, THE "ELCA SOCIAL STATEMENT ON CIVIC LIFE AND FAITH" WAS ADOPTED:

"WHEN THEY (PASTORS) SPEAK ON PUBLIC ISSUES, THE WORDS SHOULD BE ROOTED IN SCRIPTURES AND ARE TO BE GOVERNED BY OFFICIAL ELCA TEACHING."

• "WHEN THEY (PASTORS) SPEAK ON PUBLIC ISSUES, THE WORDS SHOULD BE ROOTED IN SCRIPTURES AND ARE TO BE GOVERNED BY OFFICIAL ELCA TEACHING"

THIS PASSED OVERWHELMINGLY AT THE 2025 CW ASSEMBLY. (98.3% IN FAVOR; 1.7% OPPOSED)

• WE HAVE NOT NEEDED TO FOLLOW THE ELCA VISION AND DIRECTION FOR DECADES, BECAUSE WE WERE CONFIDENT IN OUR OWN MISSION AND PURPOSE.

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- WE HAVE HAD THE <u>INDEPENDENCE</u> OF USING OUR OWN, LOCAL LEADERSHIP TO MAKE DECISIONS BASED UPON WHAT WE ARE HEARING FROM THE HOLY SPIRIT AND THE WORD OF SCRIPTURES. (FLC CONSTITUTION 9.09.01).

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- THERE HAS BEEN <u>NO METHOD</u> IN THE ELCA CONSTITUTION TO DATE <u>TO ENFORCE COMPLIANCE</u> WITH THE VISION AND DIRECTION OF THE ELCA.

• THE CRLC AND THE CW COUNCIL HAVE ESTABLISHED A TASK FORCE ON <u>INTERDEPENDENCE AND PURPOSE</u> TO CONSIDER A UNIFIED <u>STATEMENT OF PURPOSE</u> FOR ALL 3 EXPRESSIONS OF THE ELCA INCLUDING CONGREGATIONS.

• THIS TASK FORCE IS CONSIDERING THE TERM "INTERDEPENDENCE" AND WHAT THAT MEANS FOR ALL 3 EXPRESSIONS OF THE ELCA.

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"INTERDEPENDENCE" IS THE EXACT OPPOSITE OF INDEPENDENCE.

•IF CONGREGATIONS DON'T FOLLOW CHURCHWIDE'S IDEAS ABOUT WHAT THE <u>PURPOSE</u> OF THE CHURCH SHOULD BE, WHAT WOULD BE THE EXPECTED RESPONSE FROM CHURCHWIDE?

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•MANDATES ENFORCED THROUGH THE GOVERNANCE SYSTEM?

ACTIONS OF THE ELCA

 ONE TASK FORCE IS ALREADY WORKING ON ACCOUNTABILITY MEASURES AND COMPLIANCE INCENTIVES IN RESPONSE TO THE CRLC'S RECOMMENDATION FOR "IMMEDIATE ACTION ON DISMANTLING RACISM".

• IT APPEARS THAT WE ARE BEING ENCOURAGED TO FOLLOW THE ELCA TEACHINGS AND GUIDES WHEN OUR PASTORS ARE SPEAKING PUBLICLY RATHER THAN FOLLOWING THEIR OWN VISION AND GUIDANCE.

THINGS HAVE CHANGED

•AFTER REVIEWING THE DOCUMENTS AND UNDERSTANDING THE POSITIONS OF THE ELCA COUNCIL, IT IS OUR FEELING THAT THINGS HAVE SHIFTED SINCE FLC JOINED THE ELCA IN 1988.

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•AN ORIGINAL INDEPENDENT, CONGREGATIONALLY BASED ORGANIZATION IS MOVING TOWARDS A TOP-DOWN HIERARCHY IN WHICH DECISIONS ARE MADE THAT ARE ABOUT TO BECOME MANDATORY.

•CURRENTLY, WE HAVE A CONSTITUTION WITH AN "ESCAPE CLAUSE."

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•THERE ARE PROVISIONS TO LEAVE THE ELCA, BUT THE PROCESS REQUIRES 2 VOTES BY THE CONGREGATION. (SEE FLC CONSTITUTION 6.05)

• IT IS IN THE HANDS OF THE CONGREGATION TO MAINTAIN CONTROL OF THEIR OWN DESTINY WHICH INCLUDES GOVERNANCE, ASSETS, AND THE FREEDOM TO SAY AND THINK INDEPENDENTLY ABOUT THEIR OWN SOCIAL AND POLITICAL VIEWS WITH NO MANDATE TOWARD ANY PARTICULAR VIEW.

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- IT ALLOWS THE PASTORS TO PREACH THE GOSPEL AS THEY ARE CALLED TO DO WITHOUT ADDING THE "TEACHINGS" OF THE ELCA FROM THE PULPIT.

- •ANSWER: MANY PASTORS ARE THE LEADERS OF THEIR CONGREGATIONS, AND THE CONSTITUTION PREVENTS THEM FROM LEADING THE CHARGE WITHOUT FEAR OF BEING DE-ROSTERED. AND FRANKLY, THIS HAS NOT BEEN WELL PUBLICIZED TO CONGREGATIONAL LEADERSHIP.

- •WHY AREN'T ALL CONGREGATIONS LOOKING AT THESE ISSUES?
- •ANSWER: IN ADDITION, THERE SEEMS TO BE A GROWING NUMBER OF CONGREGATIONS WHO ARE BECOMING CONCERNED WITH THE DIRECTION OF THE ELCA MANIFESTED IN THE RECENT VOTE REGARDING 22.11B AMENDING THE CONSTITUTION WITHOUT CONGREGATIONAL INPUT.

•WE UNDERSTAND THAT *CHANGE* IS DIFFICULT TO ENDURE. BUT, SOMETIMES CHANGE OCCURS <u>TO YOU</u> EVEN IF YOU DO NOTHING!
