Spirit Wear Days – Students may wear jeans with St. Thomas Aquinas Spirit Wear or hunter green tops if you do not own spirit wear. Spirit wear is offered throughout the school year during spirit wear campaigns through Burghardt's sporting goods.

When the campaign is open and available, a website will be communicated to parents. Shopping is easy. You click on the link, choose your items and pay. When the campaign closes, Burghardt's will make the items, package them and I will pick them up and have them available in the office for pick-up.

Generous Jeans Days – Student's may wear jeans for a donation of \$1 or more. Student Council chooses several charities to give back to each year for generous jeans day.

Shorts – Student's may wear uniform shorts until October 1st and from May 1st through the end of the school year. These may not be cargo shorts. On WEDNESDAY or ANY mass day, PANTS are required. Students may bring shorts in their backpacks to change into after mass.

Nail polish, make-up and temporary tattoos are never to be worn at school.

Over the Counter Medicines - Over the counter medicines such as Tylenol are not available in the office. If your child is prone to headaches, or needs medicine dispensed, please ask for a form and provide the medicine with child's name and directions with the completed form to Janine Hubbell. It will be held in the office and dispensed as needed and instructed. If your child uses an inhaler, there is also an inhaler form. Please ask for the form, complete and return it with the inhaler in a large zip lock bag with your child's name on it with form inside.

Car line – PLEASE follows the rules for drop off and pick up. Again, you are NEVER to park on Norwich Street, unless you are late, or coming into the office or dropping off/picking up from extended care. EVERYONE enters on Whitnall Ave. You either drive through the car line or park in the designated parking lot and walk up to get your child. Road rage, inappropriate language and behavior by adults are completely unacceptable.

Chaperoning/Volunteering – ANYONE who wants to chaperone, volunteer, or even have lunch at school with their child MUST complete the Safeguarding God's Families class through the archdiocese and pass a background check. You may sign up for the class by going to this website.
