President's Report

It is difficult to believe we are at the start of another season. There has been good early interest in our winter events so each one of us needs to do all we can to keep COVID at bay. If you are feeling unwell, please stay home.

The first in our suite of policy documents, the **Membership Policy**, has been approved by the committee and is now available from a link on our Club Membership page. See www.sasc-aus.com/club-membership.

This policy covers all aspects of membership; it serves to provide information for members and ensure membership rules are applied consistently. Thanks to Oliver Small, Leanne Price & Duncan Sutherland for their input and David Lasky for his review.

In May some of the Club's Committee met with **Snow Australia** (SA) board member, Steve Cooper, to discuss how clubs like ours fit into the SA structure and how best to achieve benefit for both organisations.

SA have a detailed pathway for the development of elite athletes that starts with the first on snow experience. Inter-schools competition and dedicated race club training are important parts of the journey to being an elite competitor.

Although we provide support to elite and developing junior members, I feel our largest impact is at the first level where we encourage members to participate in snowsports. SA structure needs to recognise most members of Clubs enjoy snowsports at a recreational level.

Members looking at **2021/22 elite snowsports funding** should lodge applications for funding by mid-August – please see details on page 4.

Snowy Mountains Activation Project is being conducted by NSW Government to determine projects to assist development in the Snowy area. Originally launched as the Go Jindabyne master plan it has now been expanded

to include the Resorts and surrounding communities.

The draft masterplan should go on exhibition in late June, I encourage you to review the plan and make submissions via the website link – see <https://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/snowymountainssap>.

KNP day & multiday passes must be purchased at vehicle entry stations however over the next 2 years NPWS plan to have digital day passes for all NSW parks.

Past Events

March – The Sphinx Track Kuring-Gai NP
