The City of Baton Rouge-Parish of East Baton Rouge, in coordination with the Federal Transit Administration, is holding a public meeting to present the Project's Locally Preferred Alternative and to obtain comments on the Project's recently released Environmental Assessment. The Environmental Assessment evaluates the project's alternatives and identifies the potential impacts and benefits of those alternatives.

What does this project include?

The proposed project includes the construction and operation of a streetcar, or tram in an approximate three-mile north-south corridor linking the State Capitol and downtown area of Baton Rouge with the Louisiana State University (LSU) and the Old South Baton Rouge neighborhood. The tram alignment runs on N. Fourth Street/St. Ferdinand Street in downtown, transitioning via Europe Street to St. Louis Street/Nicholson Drive, and terminating just south of N. Stadium Drive at the LSU campus.
