2016 Board-building goals

As we enter our 26th year in 2016 we are courting additional Board members.

To help us more effectively fulfill our mission of preparing our students personally & academically for the world beyond the inner-city, we provide the following criteria.

We ask that all Board members agree with and help us advance our Value Statement, which we discuss with parents and students during orientation.

Value Statement

We encourage our children to think and project themselves not as victims, but as individually responsible stewards of their own behavior, choices and the resulting course they choose for their lives.

Criteria

Meetings: Commit to a minimum of 5 meetings per year; 1 quarterly and 1 Open House and/or year-end meeting.

Fundraising: Professional contribution: Make a ‘best effort at raising additional funds.’

Fundraising: Personal contribution: A \$250 personal annual contribution. Due by March 30th of every year.

Aside from obvious reasons, this criterion is important because many grant applications to foundations ask the following questions:

- 1 % of Board members attending meetings?
- 2 % of Board members making personal contributions to Strive?
- 3 Total amount contributed “personally” by Board members?
