



Timely Piano Studio offers private piano lessons while students are on the LCA campus. Lessons are scheduled during the school day saving parents valuable time driving to lessons and having to wait. Timely Piano Studio offers the highly acclaimed Royal Conservatory of Music curriculum and employs exceptionally qualified and experienced teachers. Students will receive 30 lessons during the school year and have several opportunities to perform:

- Christmas and Spring Recitals
- Community Outreach Recital in the Fall
- ACSI Southeastern District Piano Festival in the Spring – Grades 3 and up only

Cost/Registration

Registration Fee:

A one-time, non-refundable registration fee of \$150.00 is due at the time of enrollment. This annual fee covers administrative costs, recital music, instructional materials and the first set of lesson books for the current school year. Additional music and material may incur a separate fee.

Tuition:

- \$ 1,050 per year for 20-minute private lessons.
- \$ 1,200 per year for 30-minute private lessons.
- \$ 1,400 per year for 45-minute private lessons.

Payment Options:

1. Tuition may be paid in advance or in 10 monthly installments, August through May, as follows:
 - \$ 105 per month for 20-minute private lessons.
 - \$ 120 per month for 30-minute private lessons.
 - \$ 140 per month for 45-minute private lessons.
2. A 5% discount is available for tuition that is paid in full by August 31, 2018

New Piano Studios – Trial Sign Up

New piano students only may sign up for a 10 lesson trial period. The cost is 1/3 of the yearly tuition and must be paid in full along with the Registration Fee at the time of enrollment. All other students must enroll in lessons for the entire year. See Policy Brochure for more information.

Class Day/Time/Age

- Lower School students will have their lesson in lieu of recess one day per week. If these openings fill, the classroom teacher will be consulted to determine an alternate lesson time that is not disruptive to the student's academic schedule.
- Middle and High School students are scheduled before or after school.
