8. Complete Trade Certificate in Automotive Mechanical Technology.

2. Keen interest in working on cars and associated components including repairing mechanical items.
3. Good numeracy, verbal and written communication skills.
4. Demonstrated understanding in maintaining a safe working environment and commitment to Workplace Health and Safety Regulations.
5. Commitment to flexibility to perform other related duties in emergent situations.
6. Ability to operate small machines and hand held implements and tools.

Desirable Selection Criteria:

1. General knowledge of Workplace Health and Safety Policy in the workplace.
2. Willingness to undertake further training to provide an effective and efficient service in the position.
