NACC Conference Call for Papers – Deadline Extended to February 28th

The Nonprofit Academic Center Council (NACC) will be hosting its **2015 Conference on Nonprofit & Philanthropic Studies** in Chicago at DePaul University from July 15-16, 2015. The theme is “*The Meaning of ‘Nonprofitness,’ Capturing it in Research, Curriculum, & Programming.*” This conference brings together academics, scholars, practitioners, and administrators from around the world to discuss, learn and share tactics and methods that support and build university-based educational programs focused on nonprofit and philanthropic studies. Topics for conversation include instruction, pedagogy, research and substantive issues in education and administration. Graduate students are also encouraged to submit.
