It is currently one of the leading journals in the field of nonprofit management.

The new editor, who will have earned significant distinction in the field of nonprofit management and leadership, will lead *NML* and be charged with raising its profile among researchers and practitioners. The editor must hold a Ph.D. in a relevant academic discipline and have a record as a scholar, have extensive experience in evaluating and working with research manuscripts and their authors, be able to work effectively with journal staff and an editorial board, and manage journal operations efficiently.

In order to become a member of Nu Lambda Mu, a student must:

- Be a current graduate student or possess a graduate or certificate from a NACC-affiliated program.
- Have completed a minimum of 50 percent of their required degree-program coursework, or all required coursework for a graduate certificate.
- Hold a minimum 3.7 GPA.
