Partner with us: *You can participate in the work for immigrant justice by becoming an IMIrJ member.* IMIrJ membership helps to sustain our organization so that that we can continue the important work of promoting immigrant justice in our community. By becoming a member, you are demonstrating your commitment to welcoming the strangers, keeping families together, and respecting the dignity and worth of *all* people.

What membership means: *Membership is about building power and community;* the more members, the stronger our demonstration of support to policymakers, decision-makers, and especially to the immigrant community. All members are encouraged to participate in our monthly volunteer gatherings, special events and in ongoing activities.

Individual Membership Options: Membership dues are sliding scale, beginning at \$50 per year for an individual. A monthly, sustaining membership is an affordable way to support our work and provides us with a reliable income! Most monthly members contribute at least \$120 per year, or \$10 per month. We also offer labor-equity opportunities, where members contribute volunteer work instead of paying monetary dues.

Congregational Membership Options: For faith communities, membership begins at \$200 per year, or \$1 per family unit per year. We encourage your community to select an amount that works for your annual budget and your goals for immigrant justice!
