The Next Phase of Redesign Rupert

Prince Rupert, August 21st, 2018 – In partnership with the City of Prince Rupert and Community Futures, Redesign Rupert is excited to be starting work on Phase II, the next step in designing the future of Prince Rupert.

Led by Project Coordinator Ceilidh Marlow, Phase II of Redesign Rupert will be actively developing strategies and solutions to the community needs identified through Redesign's community outreach work. Phase I of Redesign Rupert, which closed in 2017, allowed the Redesign Rupert team to identify three main themes that have the potential to improve quality of life in Prince Rupert: downtown revitalization; public waterfront development & access; and improved access to human capital, skills upgrading, and professional development. Phase II of Redesign Rupert will focus on forming strategic partnerships to deliver key initiatives that support community revitalization centred around these three themes.
