

Knowing Jesus: John 8

Day 1: John 8:1-11

Weekly Catechism: (NewCityCatechism.org)

- Q14: Did God create us unable to keep his law?
- A: **No, but because of the disobedience of our first parents, Adam and Eve**, all of creation is fallen; **we are all born in sin and guilt**, corrupt in our nature and **unable to keep God's law**.

READ:

They went each to his own house, but Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. [2] Early in the morning he came again to the temple. All the people came to him, and he sat down and taught them. [3] The scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in adultery, and placing her in the midst [4] they said to him, *“Teacher, this woman has been caught in the act of adultery. [5] Now in the Law Moses commanded us to stone such women. So what do you say?”*⁶ This they said to test him, that they might have some charge to bring against him. Jesus bent down and wrote with his finger on the ground. [7] And as they continued to ask him, he stood up and said to them, *“Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her.”* [8] And once more he bent down and wrote on the ground. [9] But when they heard it, they went away one by one, beginning with the older ones, and Jesus was left alone with the woman standing before him. [10] Jesus stood up and said to her, *“Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?”* [11] She said, *“No one, Lord.”* And Jesus said, *“Neither do I condemn you; go, and from now on sin no more.”* - **John 8:1-11 ESV**

Teach/Talk: Talk about what you observe from this passage. What stands out to you? What can we learn?

- Suggested Question: What is Jesus trying to show this woman caught in sin? How does that affect you?

PRAY:

Pray through the text and for your family's specific needs.

- Suggested Prayer: Thank God that he is a righteous judge and does not overlook sin. Thank him for sending Jesus to die on the cross for your sin.

SING:

Play or sing a family favorite worship song, hymn, or kids church song.

Day 2: John 8:12-20

Weekly Catechism: (NewCityCatechsim.org)

- Q14: Did God create us unable to keep his law?
- A: **No, but because of the disobedience of** our first parents, **Adam and Eve**, all of creation is fallen; **we are all born in sin and guilt**, corrupt in our nature and **unable to keep God's law**.

READ:

[12] Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, *"I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."* [13] So the Pharisees said to him, *"You are bearing witness about yourself; your testimony is not true."* [14] Jesus answered, *"Even if I do bear witness about myself, my testimony is true, for I know where I came from and where I am going, but you do not know where I come from or where I am going. [15] You judge according to the flesh; I judge no one. [16] Yet even if I do judge, my judgment is true, for it is not I alone who judge, but I and the Father who sent me. [17] In your Law it is written that the testimony of two people is true. [18] I am the one who bears witness about myself, and the Father who sent me bears witness about me."* [19] They said to him therefore, *"Where is your Father?"* Jesus answered, *"You know neither me nor my Father. If you knew me, you would know my Father also."* [20] These words he spoke in the treasury, as he taught in the temple; but no one arrested him, because his hour had not yet come. - **John 8:12-20 (ESV)**

Teach/Talk: Talk about what you observe from this passage. What stands out to you? What can we learn?

- Suggested Question: How do you ultimately know Jesus is true?

PRAY:

Pray through the text and for your family's specific needs.

- Suggested Prayer: Thank God for shining light into a dark world. Ask him to give you more of the *'light of life'* so that you can be a part of pushing back what's dark in this world.

SING:

Play or sing a family favorite worship song, hymn, or kids church song.

DAY 3: John 8:21-30

Weekly Catechism: (NewCityCatechsim.org)

- Q14: Did God create us unable to keep his law?
- A: **No, but because of the disobedience of** our first parents, **Adam and Eve**, all of creation is fallen; **we are all born in sin and guilt**, corrupt in our nature and **unable to keep God's law**.

READ:

[21] So he said to them again, *"I am going away, and you will seek me, and you will die in your sin. Where I am going, you cannot come."* [22] So the Jews said, *"Will he kill himself, since he says, 'Where I am going, you cannot come'?"* [23] He said to them, *"You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world. [24] I told you that you would die in your sins, for unless you believe that I am he you will die in your sins."* [25] So they said to him, *"Who are you?"* Jesus said to

them, *“Just what I have been telling you from the beginning. [26] I have much to say about you and much to judge, but he who sent me is true, and I declare to the world what I have heard from him.”* [27] They did not understand that he had been speaking to them about the Father. [28] So Jesus said to them, *“When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing on my own authority, but speak just as the Father taught me. [29] And he who sent me is with me. He has not left me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to him.”* [30] As he was saying these things, many believed in him. - **John 8:21-30 (ESV)**

Teach/Talk: Talk about what you observe from this passage. What stands out to you? What can we learn?

- Suggested Question: Jesus tells them they will die in their sins but then tells them that if they believe then they won't. What's he doing?

PRAY:

Pray through the text and for your family's specific needs.

- Suggested Prayer: Thank Jesus for dying for your sin. Because of that we will not die in our sins. Ask God to make you a person that does what is pleasing to him, just like Jesus.

SING:

Play or sing a family favorite worship song, hymn, or kids church song.

Day 4: John 8:31-38

Weekly Catechism: (NewCityCatechism.org)

- Q14: Did God create us unable to keep his law?
- A: **No, but because of the disobedience of** our first parents, **Adam and Eve**, all of creation is fallen; **we are all born in sin and guilt**, corrupt in our nature and **unable to keep God's law.**

READ:

[31] So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, *“If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, [32] and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”* [33] They answered him, *“We are offspring of Abraham and have never been enslaved to anyone. How is it that you say, ‘You will become free’?”*

[34] Jesus answered them, *“Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin. [35] The slave does not remain in the house forever; the son remains forever. [36] So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed. [37] I know that you are offspring of Abraham; yet you seek to kill me because my word finds no place in you. [38] I speak of what I have seen with my Father, and you do what you have heard from your father.”* - **John 8:31-38 (ESV)**

Teach/Talk: Talk about what you observe from this passage. What stands out to you? What can we learn?

- Suggested Question: After the Jews believed what does Jesus say is the next step? How would you explain abiding in Jesus's words?

PRAY:

Pray through the text and for your family's specific needs.

- Suggested Prayer: Thank Jesus for setting you free from sin. Ask him to take you further and deeper into that truth.

SING:

Play or sing a family favorite worship song, hymn, or kids church song.

Day 5: John 8:39-59 (ESV)

Weekly Catechism: (NewCityCatechsim.org)

- Q14: Did God create us unable to keep his law?
→ A: **No, but because of the disobedience of** our first parents, **Adam and Eve**, all of creation is fallen; **we are all born in sin and guilt**, corrupt in our nature and **unable to keep God's law**.

READ:

[39] They answered him, "Abraham is our father." Jesus said to them, "If you were Abraham's children, you would be doing the works Abraham did, [40] but now you seek to kill me, a man who has told you the truth that I heard from God. This is not what Abraham did. [41] You are doing the works your father did." They said to him, "We were not born of sexual immorality. We have one Father—even God." [42] Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love me, for I came from God and I am here. I came not of my own accord, but he sent me. [43] Why do you not understand what I say? It is because you cannot bear to hear my word. [44] You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies. [45] But because I tell the truth, you do not believe me. [46] Which one of you convicts me of sin? If I tell the truth, why do you not believe me? [47] Whoever is of God hears the words of God. The reason why you do not hear them is that you are not of God."

[48] The Jews answered him, "Are we not right in saying that you are a Samaritan and have a demon?" [49] Jesus answered, "I do not have a demon, but I honor my Father, and you dishonor me. [50] Yet I do not seek my own glory; there is One who seeks it, and he is the judge. [51] Truly, truly, I say to you, if anyone keeps my word, he will never see death." [52] The Jews said to him, "Now we know that you have a demon! Abraham died, as did the prophets, yet you say, 'If anyone keeps my word, he will never taste death.' [53] Are you greater than our father Abraham, who died? And the prophets died! Who do you make yourself out to be?" [54] Jesus answered, "If I glorify myself, my glory is nothing. It is my Father who glorifies me, of whom you say, 'He is our God.' [55] But you have not known him. I know him. If I were to say that I do not know him, I would be a liar like you, but I do know him and I keep his word. [56] Your father Abraham rejoiced that he would see my day. He saw it and was glad." [57] So the Jews said to him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have you seen

Abraham?" [58] Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I am." [59] So they picked up stones to throw at him, but Jesus hid himself and went out of the temple.

- John 8:39-59 (ESV)

Teach/Talk: Talk about what you observe from this passage. What stands out to you? What can we learn?

→ Suggested Question: What is the major reason these Jews aren't hearing God?

PRAY:

Pray through the text and for your family's specific needs.

→ Suggested Prayer: Thank God that you, as a believer, will 'never taste death' (That's amazing!). Ask him to give you appropriate amounts of joy because of that truth.

SING:

Play or sing a family favorite worship song, hymn, or kids church song.
