Each small group of 10-12 Campers will have a Camp Leader. The Leader will be responsible to ensure students experience the weekly lessons, activities, and field trips.

CAMP CHECK-IN & PAYMENT

Parents/Guardians are required to check-in campers the first day of each week they attend. At check-in, are required to pay for that week of camp.

CAMP REGISTRATION FEES

Primary Students

- Registered for Option A, B, or C:
Initial Registration Fee of \$25
(Fee Provides Camp T-shirt and Tote)

Elementary Students

- Registered for One Week or More of Option A or B:
Initial Registration Fee of \$50
(Fee provides Wild Waves Season Pass, Camp T-shirt and Camp Tote)
- Registered for Option C Only:
Initial Registration Fee of \$25
(Fee Provides Camp T-shirt and Tote)

•Elementary Students registered for Option C only who then change to an Option A or B camp week, will be required to cover the cost of entry to Wild Waves for that week, or provide an additional \$50 to cover a portion of the Wild Waves Seasons Pass.

•**Initial Registration Fees will be posted to student's account** at the time of registration. These must be paid prior to the first day of camp.

Cost is \$185 /week

Option B: Camp Week of 3 Days

Monday, Wednesday & Friday (6:00am to 6:00pm)

Cost is \$135/week

Option C: Camp Week of 2 Days

Students can attend Tuesday and Thursday (6:00am to 6:00pm)

Cost is \$85/week
