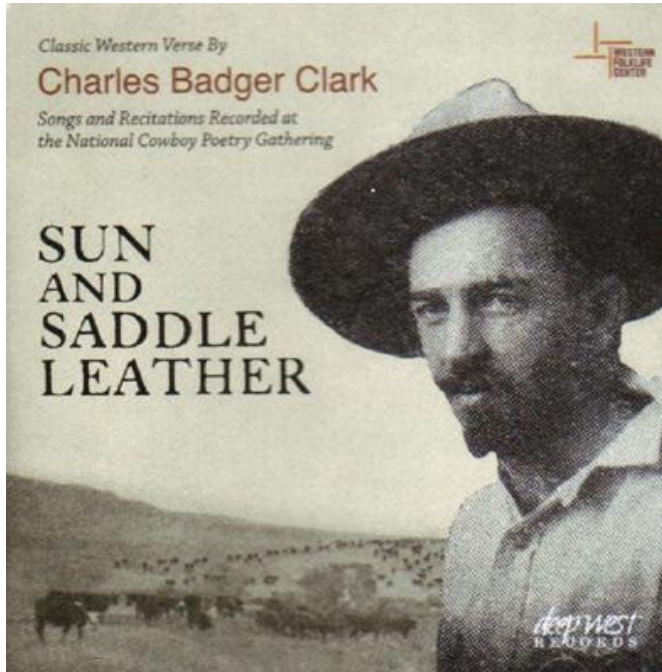


Western Folklife Center Cowboy Poetry and Music Compilation CDs

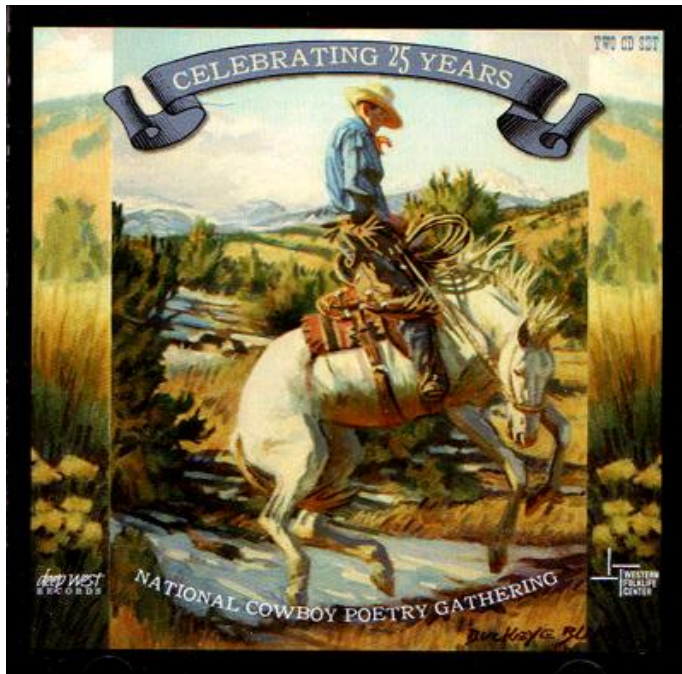

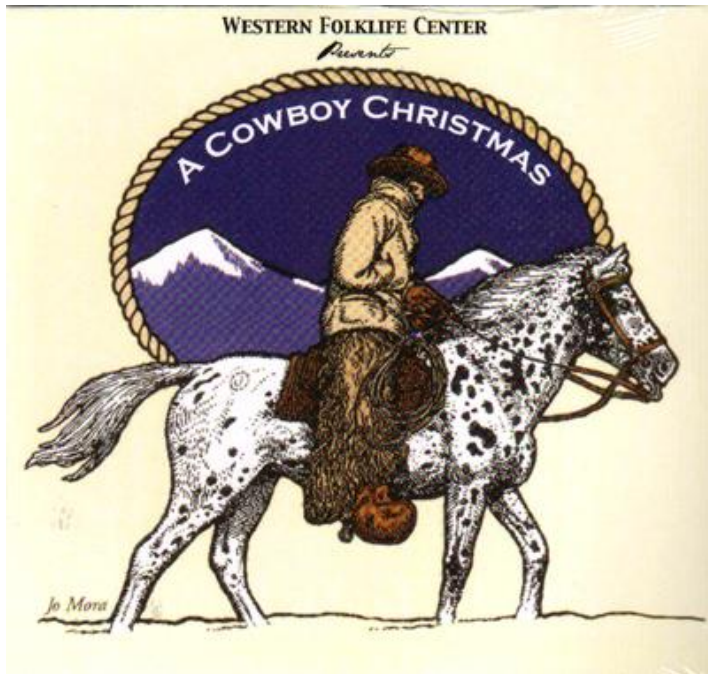
Celebrating 25 years of the National Cowboy Poetry Gathering

Premiering at the 25th *National Cowboy Poetry Gathering*, this CD is a unique double set - there is one CD of cowboy poetry and one CD of western music. This collection includes 50 performances - 25 poems and 25 songs that were recorded during a Gathering, one selection from every year.

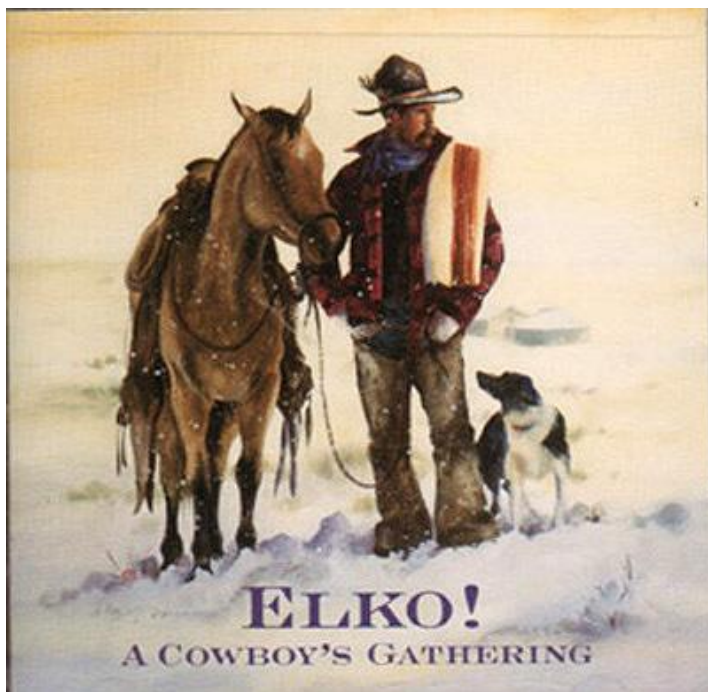
