OUT OF THE STORM PDF COMPLEX PTSD: PSYCHOLOGICAL & MEDICAL COMORBIDITY RECORD

The term "co-morbidity" refers to any additional disease or disorder (psychological or physical) that co-occurs with Complex PTSD. As there is growing recognition of causal connections between medical and psychological conditions to trauma, it is important to record yours for yourself, your physician, and in some cases mental health and/or legal professionals.
