Note on calculation of meals:

Malden Database: $42,443 \text{ bags} \times 12 \text{ meals/bag} = 509,316 \text{ meals}$

Volunteers: $2,600 \text{ visits} \times 4 \text{ bags/visit} \times 12 \text{ meals/bags} = 124,800 \text{ meals}$

Malden Database Total: $509,316 \text{ database meals} + 124,800 \text{ volunteers meals} = 634,116 \text{ meals}$

Everett Pantry: $3,789 \text{ Everett visits} / 25,309 \text{ Malden database visits} \times 509,316 \text{ Malden database meals} = 76,249 \text{ meals}$

Malden Pantry only: $634,116 \text{ meals} - 76,249 \text{ Everett Pantry meals} = 557,867 \text{ meals}$

Motels Outreach - Groceries $53,064 + \text{Meals } 13,000 = 66,064 \text{ meals total}$

Groceries: $[(87 \text{ bags/wk} \times 35 \text{ wks}) + (81 \text{ bags/wk} \times 17 \text{ wks})] \times 12 \text{ meals per bag} = 53,064 \text{ meals}$

Detail: Town Line Inn 40 bags/wk (up to 50 with 2nd bags), NE Motor Ct 16 bags/wk Jan-Aug,

Meals: $250 \text{ meals/week for } 50 \text{ weeks} = 13,000 \text{ meals}$

Meal Program: from GBFB Monthly Service Reports - for evening meals 208 days, take-home meals, breakfasts, lunches, snacks, additional deliveries to Teen Center, Stan K. house, Cedar Street, people on the street, etc. = 51,539 meals. Total Individuals served (visits, or duplicated #)=6,158 Jan-Dec, including Christmas & Thanksgiving (850 each), or 118/wk

2015 Bread of Life by the numbers:

Number of people served: about 56,319 (counting each person each time he/she is served)

Number of meals provided: 1.03 million

Geographic area served by Malden Food Pantry:

Malden: 63%, Everett: 27%, Medford: 5%, Melrose: 3%,

Combination of Saugus, Winchester, North Reading, Reading, Stoneham & Wakefield: 2%.

Ethnicities served by Malden Food Pantry:

37% identify as white/caucasian

32% as asian (Chinese, south-east asian, Indian, Paci

23% as black (African-American, African or Carribean)

8% as latino

Age breakdown served by Malden Food Pantry:

22% children

57% adults

21% senior citizens
