Fees for Provision of Data Policy

The Australian Trauma Registry is a valuable source of data about major trauma patients in Australia. Access to the data, requests for data and acknowledgement of usage of the data from the ATR database are subject to strict guidelines (see the Data Access Policy and Acknowledgement and Authorship Policy). All data summaries and analyses provided to commercial bodies and non-contributors by the ATR will incur a fee to cover the costs for staff to undertake this work.

- The minimum charge per hour of work (or part thereof) is \$100. Thus, a data analysis/report requiring 1 and a half hours of ATR time will be charged at \$150.
- The fee of \$100 per hour (or part thereof) is for basic tabulations and data extractions only. When more detailed analysis of data is required (e.g. statistical comparisons, statistical modelling, etc.), this will need to be charged at a higher rate.
- GST (10%) is also payable and the overall charge per hour (or part thereof) is therefore \$110 for a standard analysis.
- Upon receipt of a data analysis request, the ATR will send the data requester a cost estimate to undertake the work. This will normally be within 2 weeks of receipt of the request. All data requesters must agree to these costs (see below) before any data request can be met.
- An invoice will be issued on completion of the work.

I agree to the above costs and undertake to remunerate the Australian Trauma Registry (ATR) the invoiced amount on completion of the work.
