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The Holy Land & Jordan

Day 1, WED NOV 1: DEPARTURE from North America. This morning we meet at the airport for our trans-Atlantic flight to Israel.

Day 2, THU NOV 2: ISRAEL - TEL AVIV - BEERSHEBA. Upon our arrival we meet our guide and board our bus. We begin our tour of the Holy Land by first driving south through the Philistine cities on our way to Beersheba. We stop in the Valley of Elah for a view where David encountered Goliath. Then arriving in Beersheba, we visit Abraham's Well. The rest of the day is at leisure at our hotel for relaxation before dinner.

Day 3, FRI NOV 3: WILDERNESS OF ZIN - TIMNA - EILAT - PETRA. This morning we drive to view the stupendous wilderness of Zin. We continue south through the Negev, the desert region of southern Israel to visit the Tabernacle in the Wilderness, a life-size replica of the biblical tabernacle located in Timna Valley. Continue to Eilat, a busy port and resort city. See the Red Sea and visit the Underwater Observatory. Then we arrive at the Arava Border and cross into Jordan. Continue to Petra for dinner and overnight.

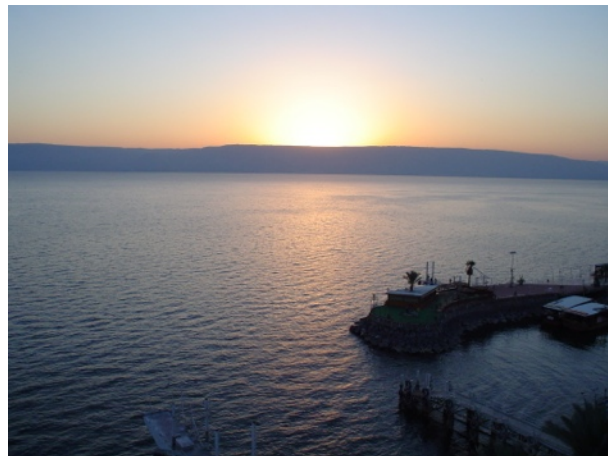


Day 4, SAT NOV 4: PETRA – SHOBAK - AMMAN. This morning after breakfast, we visit Petra. This ancient Edomite and Nabatean capital is an amazing city of prophecy. See this spectacular "City of the Dead" with its famed gorge, ancient street, temples, dwelling places and tombs carved from the solid rock. Arrive at El Ji Post and continue the one-mile journey on horseback, or walk, passing through the famous SIQ (natural gorge) and arrive at the "Treasury". Visit the ancient theater. In the Nabatean Judgment Hall, Place Tombs, famous Urn Temple and the Roman amphitheater. Those willing to climb may view the monastery, Jebel Harun

(Mountain of Aaron), supposed to be the burial place of Aaron. Horseback journey back to El Ji Post. This afternoon we drive along the Exodus route north along the famed historical King's Highway passing by the conserved Crusader castle of Shobak. From there we go to Amman - Philadelphia, the capital of Jordan, for dinner and overnight.

Day 5, SUN NOV 5: MADABA - MT. NEBO - BAPTISMAL SITE - JERICHO - JORDAN VALLEY - SEA OF GALILEE. This morning we take a short drive to Madaba, with its mosaic floor from the 6th century showing a map of the Holy Land as Christian pilgrims knew it in that period. Then to Mt. Nebo, from which God showed Moses the Promised Land. Continue for a view of the Dead Sea and then to the recently discovered baptismal site of "Bethany beyond the Jordan." For Christians, the most significant event associated with the River Jordan is undoubtedly the baptism of our Lord Jesus Christ by John the Baptist. We then proceed to the Allenby Bridge to return back to Israel. We again rejoin our bus and guide from the Holy Land. We drive to Jericho and view the traditional mountain of Jesus' temptation. Driving through the Jordan Valley we enter Harod's Valley. Jesus healed the 10 lepers here somewhere in this valley. We continue on the Ein Harod where Gideon thinned out his army as he brought them to the spring and sorted them on the basis of how they drank from the water. We drive through the Jezreel Valley back towards Beth Shean to view the setting for the death of Saul, surveying the magnificent Roman and Byzantine ruins: theatre, bathhouses, ancient rest rooms, market areas, colonnaded streets. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Tiberias.

Day 6, MON NOV 6: SEA OF GALILEE. This morning we take a replica boat ride on the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum, where we visit the synagogue and the place where early Christians



remembered Peter's house. We continue to Tabgha to view the mosaics in the Church of the Loaves and Fishes and then we ascend to the Mount of Beatitudes. Stop for a St. Peter's Fish luncheon (included). On an ancient trade route, we pass Hazor and then go on to Tel Dan. Here we take a nature walk and visit the high place where Jeroboam, son of Nebat, set up a golden calf. We continue along the east side of the sea to the Baptism site on the Jordan River. (Optional service is available) Dinner and overnight.



Day 7, TUE NOV 7: NAZARETH - MT. CARMEL - ABRAHAM'S TENT - JERUSALEM. This morning we depart Tiberias and view Mt. Tabor on the way to Nazareth, visiting the ancient village. Our day continues as we ascend Mt. Carmel, site of Elijah's confrontation with the prophets of Baal with a beautiful view of the valley. After descending the mountain, we drive toward the south to Abraham's Tent to re-live the old customs. Enjoy the activities here before an early dinner at the tent. Continue on to the Holy City of Jerusalem for overnight.

Day 8, WED NOV 8: JERUSALEM - MT OF OLIVES - GETHSEMANE - BETHLEHEM. We begin our day on the Mt. of Olives and a panoramic view of the Old City. We will descend the traditional Palm Sunday road to Dominus Flevit, remembering Jesus' entry. We continue to Gethsemane to visit the garden and the church. Then we drive to Mt. Zion to the grounds of a church called Peter in Gallicantu, affording us the best view of early Jerusalem. Traveling south, we drive by Solomon's Pools, Jerusalem's main source of water for almost 2000 years. Passing the monastery of Hortus Conclusus in Artas, we go to Shepherds' Fields. Then continue with a visit to Bethlehem, walking through its alleys and markets to the Church of the Nativity. Return to Jerusalem passing Rachel's Tomb (if viewable) and Ein Karem. Then to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 9, THU NOV 9: JERUSALEM - THE OLD CITY. Just inside the Dung Gate, we examine the ruins near the south side of the Temple complex, including steps where Jesus and the disciples walked. We walk up to the Western Wall, Judaism's holiest site. Visit the Rabbinical Tunnel (by appointment only). We view the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock that was built on the ancient site of Solomon's Temple (Genesis 22:9-14) and over the Rock of Sacrifice where Abraham offered Isaac (Genesis 22) and the ceremonial sacrifice of animals took place. Just to the north we find the Pools of Bethesda and St. Anne's Church preserved from the Crusader period. We follow the Way of the Cross (Via Dolorosa) back as far as the Holy Sepulcher and from there we walk through the Christian Quarter through the Arab Souks past the Armenian Quarter and exit the Old City. Outside the Mt Zion Gate we visit the Upper Room and King David's Tomb. Our day concludes at the Garden Tomb for a special visit and private communion. Dinner and overnight.

Day 10, FRI NOV 10: NEW JERUSALEM - JOPPA - Airport. This morning we have some time at leisure before check-out at the hotel. Then we visit New Jerusalem: the Israel Museum, the Shrine of the Book that houses the Dead Sea Scrolls and the Model City of Jerusalem which depicts in miniature the Holy City as it appeared in the first century. After lunch continue to Emmaus where Jesus appeared after Resurrection (Luke 24:30-31). Our afternoon drive will take us to Ancient Joppa on the Sea where Jonah set sail and where Peter raised Dorcas from the dead. Joppa was also the home of Simon the Tanner. Then to a local restaurant for a Farewell Dinner. We continue to the airport for our late evening flight to the U.S.

Day 11, SAT NOV 11: TEL AVIV - USA. Early morning arrival in the U.S. The end of a most enjoyable journey.
