# The Holy Land

**Day 1: TUE, SEP 12: USA - ISRAEL.** Tour members meet at the airport three hours prior to departure. Dinner and breakfast are served in flight.

**Day 2: WED, SEP 13: TEL AVIV - JERUSALEM.** Upon our arrival at the Tel Aviv airport, we are met and continue to our beautiful hotel in Jerusalem where the thrilling journey of following in the footsteps of Jesus begins. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

**Day 3: THU, SEP 14: JERUSALEM.** After a night of rest and a hearty breakfast, this exciting day begins with a drive to Mt. Scopus and the Mt. of Olives (*Matthew 24:3*) for a panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem, visiting the Chapel of the Ascension, the Church of Pater Noster and the Dominus Flevit. Walk along Hosanna Road to the Gethsemane to visit the Church of All Nations which stands on the Rock of Agony where Jesus was betrayed by Judas (*Matthew 26:36-57*). See the Pillar of Absalom, the Eastern (Golden) Gate and the Pinnacle of the Temple. Continue to tour New Jerusalem: Hebrew University, the Shrine of the Book that houses the Dead Sea Scrolls, Yad Vashem - the immensely moving memorial to the six million martyrs of the Holocaust - and the Israel Museum. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Day 4: FRI, SEP 15: JERUSALEM - BETHLEHEM - JERUSALEM.** This morning, we drive to Bethlehem where we visit the Church of the Nativity, the birthplace of Jesus and Shepherds Fields (*Luke 2:1-20*) then the Field of Boaz and Ruth (*Ruth*



*1:16-17 & 4:13*). Then, we visit the Canavanti Bros. gift shop for lunch and shopping. Return to Jerusalem to the City of David to see the Spring Citadel exhibition, Gihon Spring and Hezekiah's Tunnel which was dug underneath the City of David during ancient times (no wading). Then to the Temple Mount Ascent. See the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock that was built on the ancient site of Solomon's Temple (*Genesis 22:9-14*) and over the Rock of Sacrifice where Abraham offered Isaac (*Genesis 22*) and the ceremonial sacrifice of animals took place. Also the Southern Steps where Jesus stood. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.


**Day 5: SAT, SEP 16: JERUSALEM.** This morning we drive to Mt. Zion where we visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu on the site of Caiphas' House, the Room of the Last Supper (*Luke 22:14-20*) and the Tomb of King David. We then walk along the Via Dolorosa to Pilate's Judgment Hall, the Chapel of the Flagellation, the Ecce Homo Arch (*John 19:13*) where Jesus was tried before Pilate (*Mark 15:6*). We last visit the Garden Tomb and Golgotha Calvary - Place of the Skull for a worship service. Some time at leisure in the Old City with our guide. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

**Day 6: SUN, SEP 17: JERUSALEM.** Today begins with a tour through the Rabbinical Tunnel (by appointment only). Then continue with the Old City of Jerusalem. Start at the Western (Wailing) Wall where the faithful Jews cry their petitions to God. Visit the Burnt House, in testimony of the burning of Jerusalem by the Romans. We then visit the Cardo, Jerusalem's main street 1500 years ago. Then to the Temple Institute. Continue to David's Citadel for a leisurely visit. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Day 7: MON, SEP 18: BETHANY - MASADA - EIN GEDI - QUMRAN - VILLAGE OF THE ESSENES - QUMRAN CAVES - JERICO - OLD JERICO - MT. OF TEMPTATION - JERUSALEM.** This morning we drive via the Judean Desert towards the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. First we stop at Bethany, the home of Mary, Martha and Lazarus (*John 11:1-46*). A beautiful new road takes us south along the shores of the Dead Sea to Masada, truly a remarkable piece of history. Ascend Masada by cable car to visit the magnificent ruins of the fortress where, from 70-73 A.D., the Jewish defenders made the last stand of the Judean revolt against Rome, and where the remains of storehouses, cisterns and a 6th century Byzantine church are still on view. Then we visit Ein Gedi, a green oasis in the middle of the desert. Drive along the Dead Sea to Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Visit the remains of the Community Center of the Essenes and the Caves of the Scrolls. Continue to Bethany, the home of Mary, Martha and Lazarus (*John 11:1-46*) for a visit. Then to ancient Jericho where the walls came tumbling down and a commanding view of the Mt. of Temptation (*Matt. 4:1-11*) and Elisha's Fountain. On to the Jericho Road viewing the Inn of the Good Samaritan (*Luke 10:25-37*) and the Judean wilderness. Return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight at our hotel.

**Day 8: TUE, SEP 19: JERUSALEM - BETHSHEAN - MT. TABOR - GALILEE - NAZARETH - SEPPHORIS - CANA - TIBERIAS ON THE SEA OF GALILEE.** This morning, traveling northward from Jerusalem, we visit Bethshean. Continue to Nazareth, the hometown of Jesus, in the Province of Galilee. Here we visit the church of the Annunciation (*Luke 1:5-42*) and Mary's Fountain (*Luke 4:16-22*). Visit the Nazareth Village and the Nazareth Synagogue. We have a chance to visit another beautiful archeological site named Sepphoris. We then proceed to Cana, the site of the first miracle of Jesus (*John 2:1-11*) and then to Tiberias (*John 6:23*) and the beautiful Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Tiberias.

**Day 9: WED, SEP 20: TIBERIAS - SEA OF GALILEE - CAPERNAUM - MT. OF BEATITUDES - TABGHA - CAESAREA PHILIPPI - BANIAS - MT. HERMON - GOLAN HEIGHTS.** This will be an exciting day in the Galilee area. After a delicious breakfast, we depart the Roman hot springs resort city of Tiberias via a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee. Then we drive to the Kibbutz, Nof Ginnosar to see the Jesus Boat. Continue to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount (*Matthew 5-7*), and to Tabgha, the chapel dedicated to the multiplication of the loaves and fishes (*Mark 6:34-44*). We then proceed to Upper Galilee and visit the archeological site of Banias. Next, we visit the site of



Peter's Confession (*Matthew 16:16*) at Caesarea Philippi and to Mt. Hermon (*Psalms 89:12*), the probable site of the Transfiguration (*Matthew 17:1-8*) and the present day Golan Heights where Israel, Lebanon and Syria come together. On our return to Tiberias we stop at Capernaum (*John 6:24*) to visit the ancient ruins of this first century synagogue where Jesus preached (*Matthew 4:13-17*) and Tabgha - the chapel dedicated to the multiplication of the loaves and fishes - (*Mark 6:34-44*). Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Day 10: THU, SEP 21: TIBERIAS - JORDAN RIVER - MEGIDDO - MEDITERRANEAN COAST - AIRPORT.** This morning we follow the fresh mountain waters of Hermon to the Sea of Galilee and to the outlet passage at the southern tip of the sea where we stop at the beautiful Pilgrims Park at the Jordan River. Time for a Believer's Baptism in the River Jordan. We then head **back to our hotel to shower** and prepare for our late hotel check-out. We drive to Megiddo and the fields of Armageddon (*Revelation 16:16*) in the Jezreel Valley. Time permitting, we visit Haifa and Mt. Carmel, the biblical site of Elijah's contest with the prophets of Baal (*I Kings 18*). Continue southward along the Way of the Sea to Caesarea, the Roman City of Herod where sights include Crusader fortifications and the Roman aqueducts and amphitheater. Drive through the citrus groves and farms of the rich land of Sharon to ancient Joppa on the Sea where Jonah set sail, and where Peter raised Dorcas from the dead. Joppa also was the home of Simon the Tanner. Continue to a local restaurant for our farewell dinner. Then we transfer to the airport for our flight home.

**Day 11: FRI, SEP 22: NORTH AMERICA - USA.** Early arrival in the US, and then continue home - the end of our most enjoyable journey.
