Your ongoing support makes local conservation possible. Thank you!

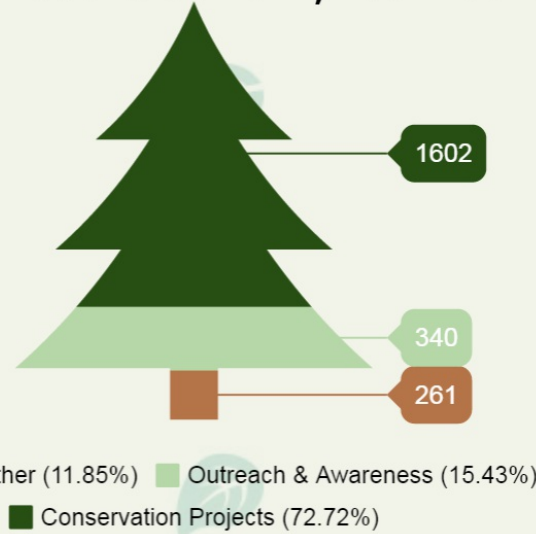

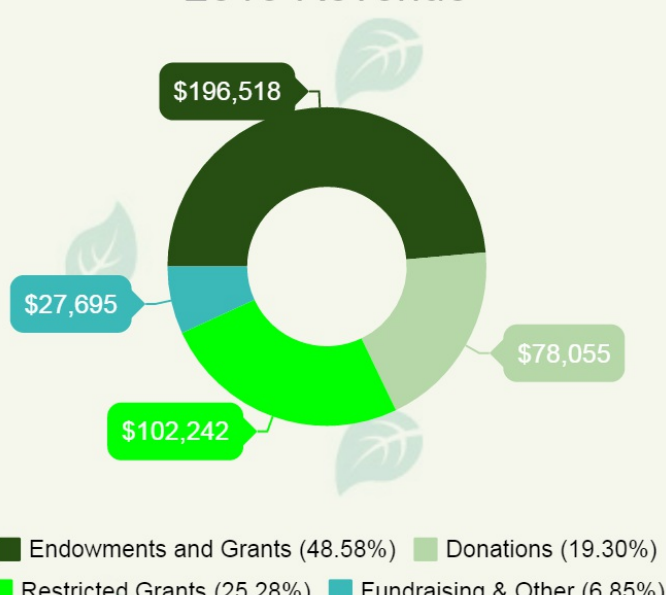

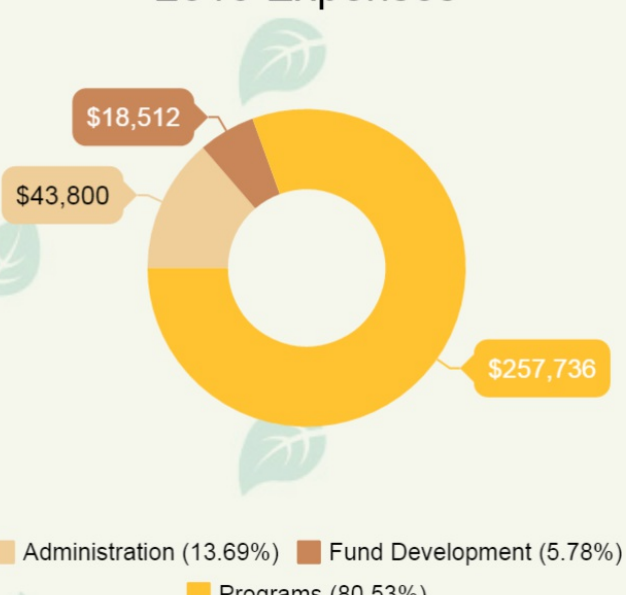


2015 Financials
