We also launched a fundraising initiative to secure 1.5 quarters in the heart of Edmonton, comprised of both old growth forest and over 120 acres of agricultural land!

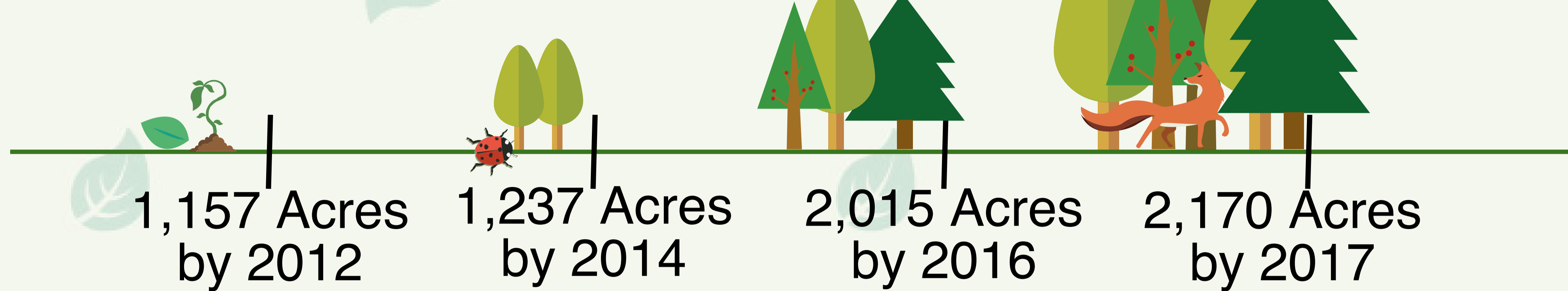
Our supporters make this work possible, and are incredibly generous with their time, talents, and donating funds or even precious land.

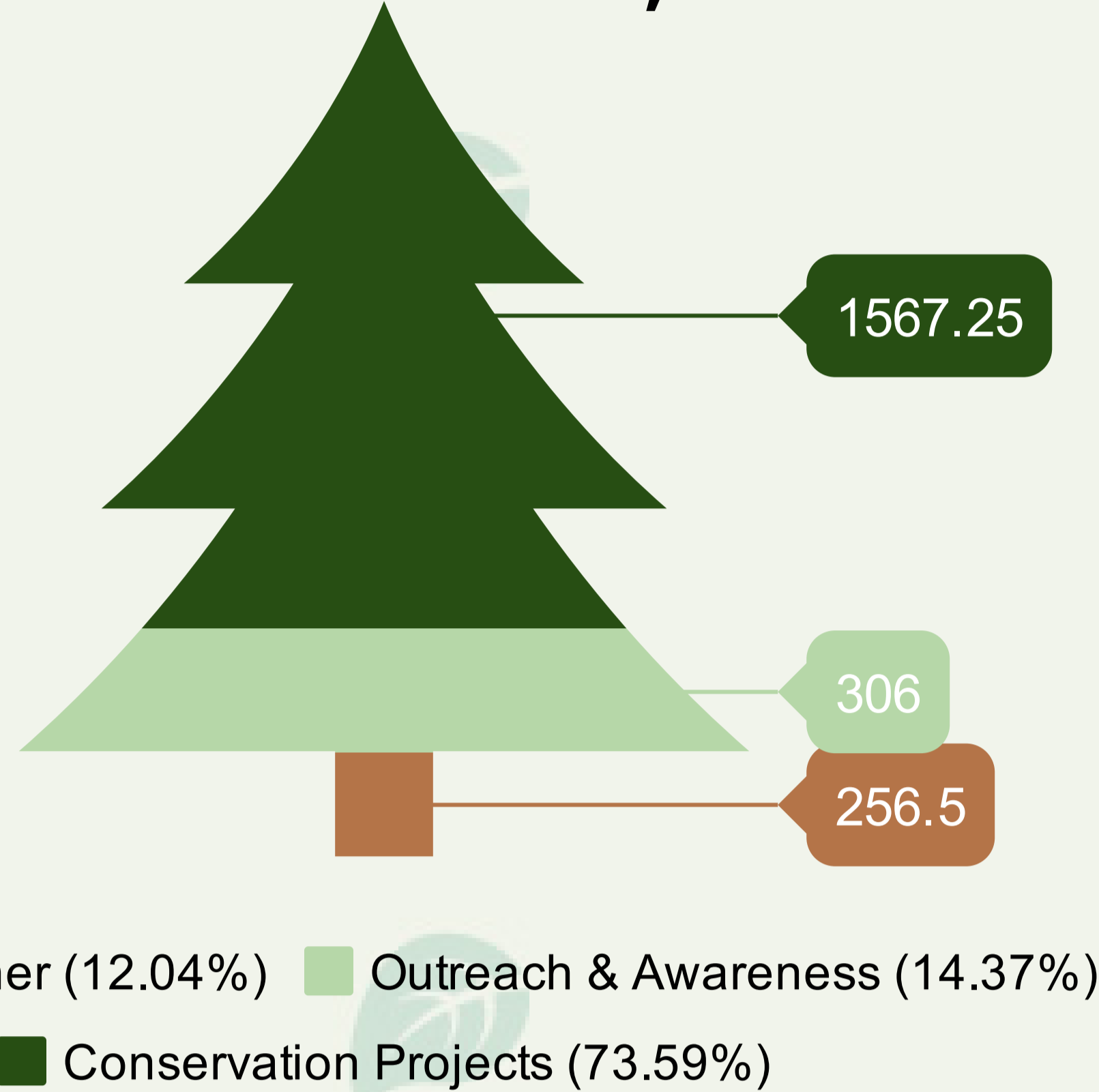

"Bat populations across Canada are being threatened by a disease: white-nose syndrome. This is a fungus that grows on the bats' face and body, waking them while in hibernation and resulting in their death. The disease has not spread to Alberta yet, but it is prevalent in eastern Canada and has recently been found in western North America. Due to mass die offs, little brown bats are now federally listed as an Endangered species."

For his bachelor party, Matt and his buddies planted native wildflower species at Boisvert's GreenWoods!

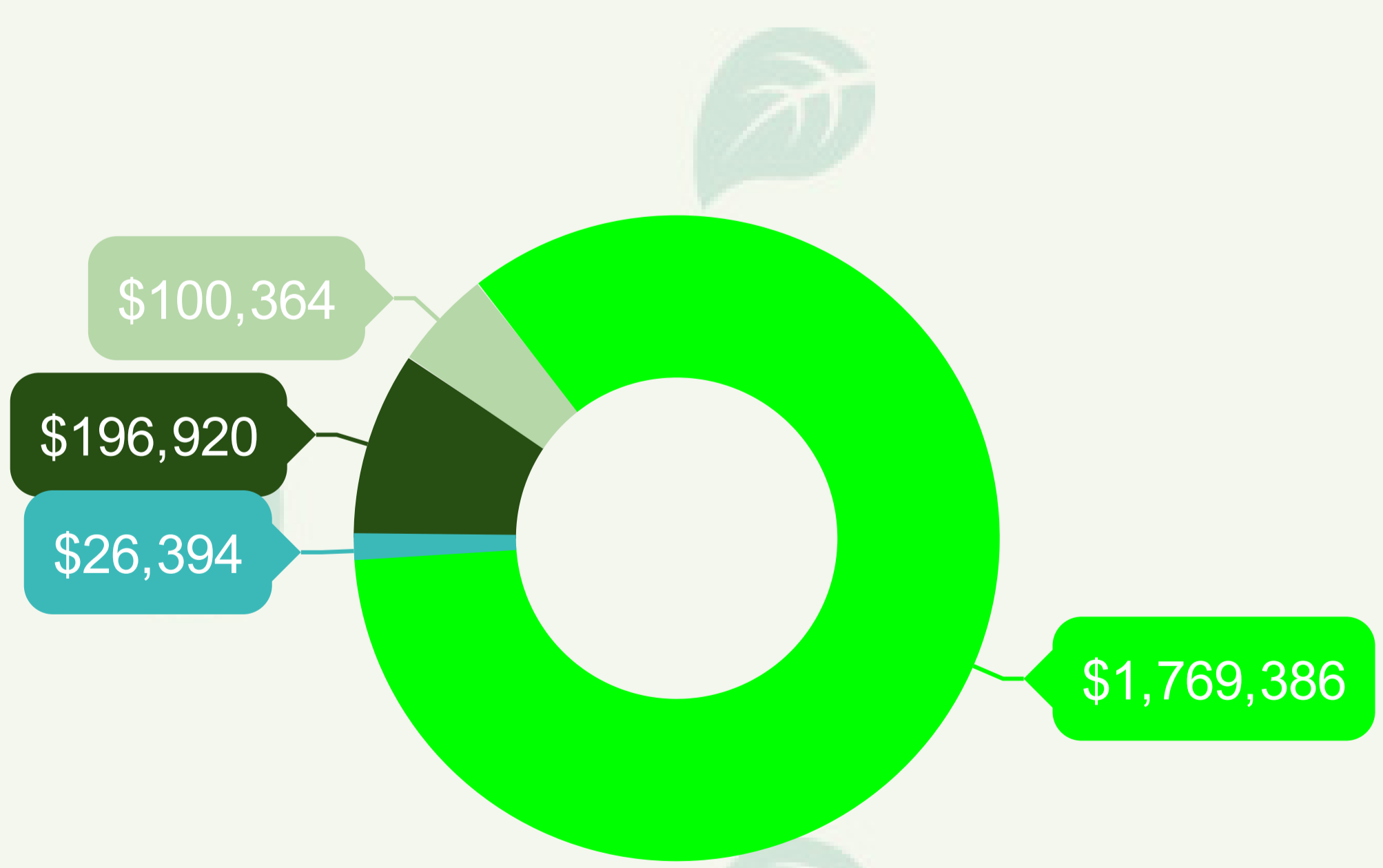

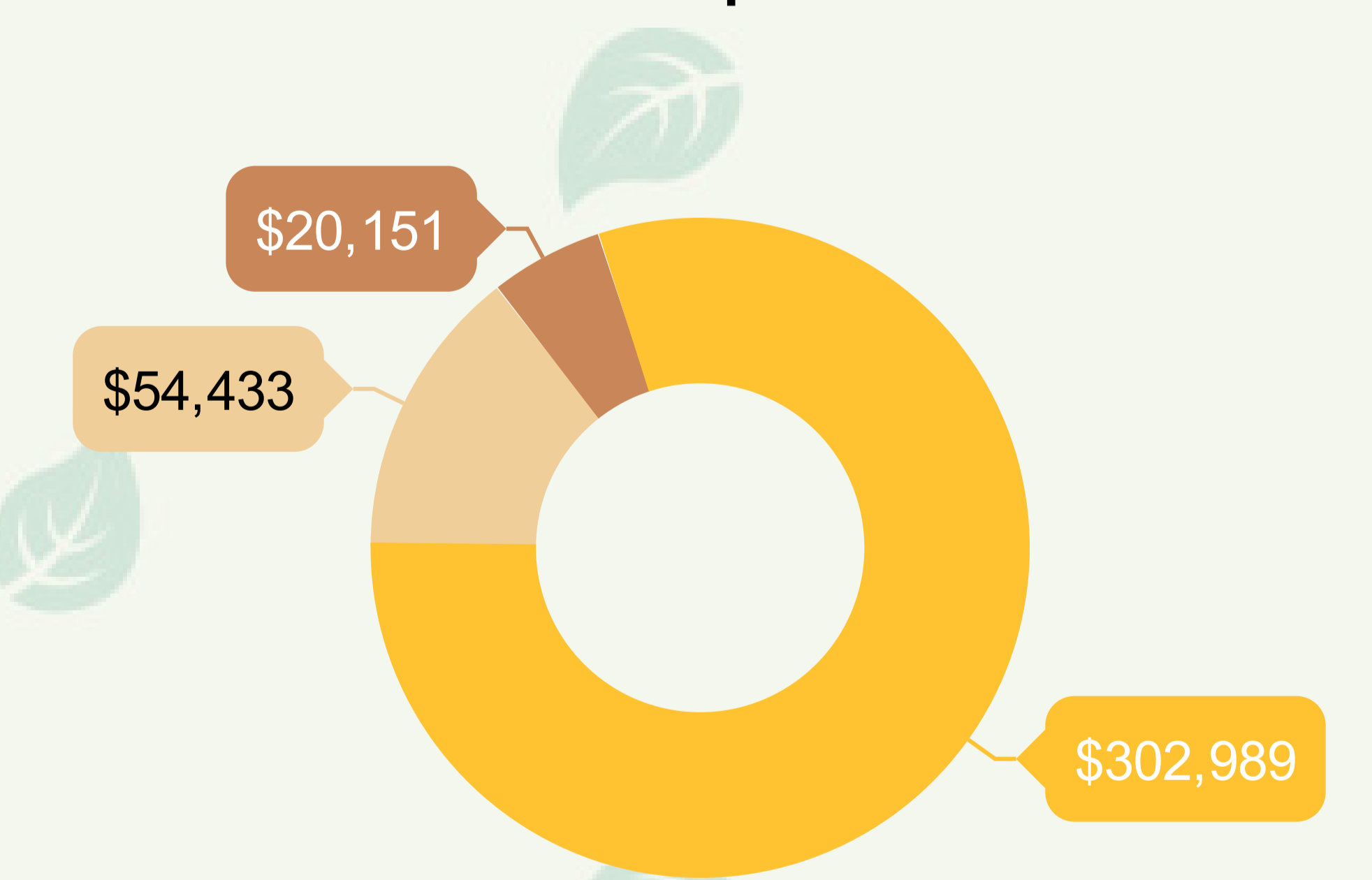
