- Outstanding communication skills, both written and verbal.
- Trail-side bike repairs (tube change, chain repairs, and minor adjustments)

- Knowledge of the North Shore trail networks (or willingness to put the miles in and quickly learn).
- Owns a current and well maintained mountain bike, equipped guides pack, and cell phone.
