# letter from our president

I am pleased to present the Annual Report for Assistance League of the Eastside for the 2012-13 fiscal year. Your generosity this past year enabled our organization to move our philanthropic programs to greater levels of effectiveness and achieve our vision to positively impact our community – one individual at a time.

This year we were able to increase the budget for our biggest philanthropic program, Operation School Bell® and meet the needs of more children. In addition, we increased funding for Assistance League® Outreach and collaborated with other local agencies to address one of the most compelling needs in our local community – homelessness. As a result, a new philanthropic program, Help4Homeless, was formed and is currently in the process of formalizing its approach to delivering help to homeless individuals on the Eastside.

As an organization, we worked on our overall efficiency this past year. Improvements were made to the processes of all our philanthropic programs and events. Our Information Technology committee researched, selected and implemented a web-based document sharing and collaboration tool with the help of pro bono consulting assistance from two local companies, Point B, Inc. and WebOnyx. The tool will improve our ability to deliver the services of our philanthropic programs to people in need in our community.

This Annual Report calls out the successes of last year and allows us to thank you for your critical support. Since our founding in 1997, we have returned over \$3.65 million to the Eastside community through our philanthropic programs. But the need continues to grow. We hope you continue to invest in the philanthropic programs of Assistance League of the Eastside and help us put caring and commitment into action.

# financial summary



Assistance League of the Eastside members work hard to raise the funds necessary to operate our philanthropic programs. Revenue is generated through donations, grants and special events. The fundraising goal for fiscal year 2012-13 was \$369,175. We are proud to report that each of our fundraising efforts exceeded its revenue target.

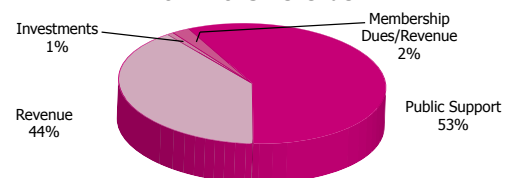
The business community continued to show its backing of our programs by contributing in-kind donations and sponsoring events. The Grantwriting Committee was successful in obtaining grants totaling over \$136,000 with significant support coming from the Cities of Bellevue, Redmond, Kirkland and Sammamish, Fred Meyer Stores, Wockner Foundation and Windermere Foundation. A complete list of our donors, grantors, and sponsors is included in this report.

The Celebrations Holiday Home Tour, featuring five decorated homes in Kirkland garnered record attendance and generated revenue of \$54,000. Our Spring Event, the Corks for a Cause Dinner and Auction, was held at the Golf Club of Newcastle and brought in over \$266,000 to fund our programs. At this same event, we honored long time sponsor SNC-Lavalin with the 2013 National Operation School Bell® Award.

Aware of the fiduciary responsibilities, Assistance League of the Eastside continued to follow the BBB/Wise Giving Alliance Standards for Charitable Accountability in fiscal year 2012-2013. Following our mission of putting caring and commitment into action, 82% of every dollar spent went directly to the community through our philanthropic programs.

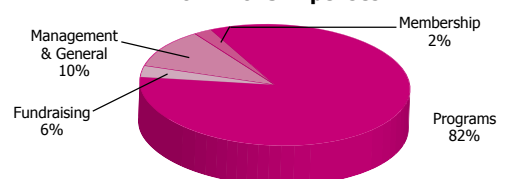

**Assistance League of the Eastside** contributes to a strong foundation for a child's successful educational experience through the **Operation School Bell®** program, in which volunteers organize local shopping events for children in need, selected by school personnel, in the Lake Washington, Bellevue and Northshore school districts. **Assistance League of the Eastside** helps to restore dignity to survivors of sexual assault by providing essential personal care items and new clothing to replace items retained as evidence by law enforcement officers, through the **Assault Survivor Kits®** program. Volunteers prepare and deliver the kits to hospitals throughout Washington where they are distributed by emergency room staff. (2012-13 Fiscal Year: 950 people received kits through this program)

**Assistance League of the Eastside** provides baskets of basic household items for individuals and families fleeing domestic violence, enabling them to begin new lives in safe, violence-free housing. Through the **Starting Over Support** program, volunteers prepare and send the baskets to domestic violence emergency shelters in King County and trained chapter members organize holiday parties and parent/teen events for people living in these shelters. (2012-13 Fiscal Year: 600 people were served by this program)

**Assistance League of the Eastside** collaborates with other local agencies to help to fill specific unmet needs in our local community in a rapid-response way through the **Assistance League Outreach** program. (2012-13 Fiscal Year: 400 people were supported by this program)

Assistance League of the Eastside members volunteered 18,222 hours this past fiscal year. Based on guidelines provided by the U.S. Department of Labor, the estimated value of these services is \$406,350.
