I am extremely proud to present the Annual Report of Assistance League of the Eastside for the 2011-2012 fiscal year. **This report summarizes how 127 volunteers, donating over 17,520 hours, have raised and spent over \$400,000 on four philanthropic programs, serving more than 4400 residents on the Eastside.**

As our programs demonstrate, Assistance League of the Eastside cares for children in need in our local community, cares about the dignity of sexual assault survivors, assists individuals and families fleeing domestic violence by providing basic household items to begin new lives in safe housing, and provides a flexible, rapid-response strategy to respond to specific needs in our local community. We recognize that it is the strength of small consistent acts that makes a difference.



Our philanthropic programs are designed to meet local needs and the funds we raise to administer them are spent locally. In this Annual Report, we celebrate generous donations from individuals, corporations and foundations that support these philanthropic programs. # our programs



**Assistance League of the Eastside** supports the belief that new school clothing, and the resulting increase in self-esteem and school attendance, contributes to a strong foundation for a child's successful educational experience. Through the **Operation School Bell** program, volunteers organize local shopping events for over 2700 children in need, selected by school personnel, from 47 schools in the Lake Washington, Bellevue and Northshore school districts.

**An Operation School Bell Mom**

**Since 1992 we have clothed over 29,000 children on the Eastside.**

**Assistance League of the Eastside** helps to restore dignity to survivors of sexual assault by providing essential personal care items and new clothing to replace items retained as evidence by law enforcement officers, through the **Assault Survivor Kits** program. Volunteers prepare and deliver the kits to hospitals throughout Washington where they are distributed by emergency room staff.

**Assistance League of the Eastside** provides baskets of basic household items for individuals and families fleeing domestic violence, enabling them to begin new lives in safe, violence-free housing. Through the **Starting Over Support** program, volunteers prepare and send the baskets to domestic violence emergency shelters in King County and trained chapter members organize holiday parties and parent/teen events for people living in these shelters.

**Since 1992 we have provided support to over 13,000 survivors of sexual assault and domestic violence.**

**Assistance League of the Eastside** collaborates with other local agencies to help in the short term to fill specific unmet needs in our local community in a timely, responsive and flexible way through the **Assistance League Outreach** program. Recent projects have provided: sturdy backpacks for homeless youths on the Eastside; socks for people living in local homeless shelters; safe infant "sleeper sacks" given to very young new parents; laundry products for a women's shelter; and toys for a local agency so clients' children could safely play while the adults met with counselors.

*Assistance League of the Eastside directly supports our district vision of "Every Student Future Ready" by helping to fulfill students' most basic needs in the present, enabling students to come to school ready to learn, grow, and prepare for their future. # financial summary



Each year the members of Assistance League of the Eastside work hard to raise the funds necessary to successfully operate our philanthropic programs. Revenue is generated through donations, grants and special events. For fiscal year 2011-12, the members of Assistance League of the Eastside were tasked with raising \$275,000; we are very proud to note that every one of our fundraising efforts exceeded its revenue target.

The business community continued to show its backing of our programs by contributing in-kind donations, sponsoring events, and hosting our Speakers Bureau so we could spread the word about Assistance League while canvassing for more donations and volunteers. The Grantwriting Committee was successful in obtaining 19 grants totaling over \$125,000, with significant support coming from Fred Meyer Stores, Wockner Foundation and Windermere Foundation again this year.

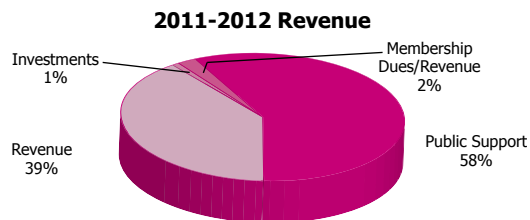
The Celebrations Holiday Home Tour, featuring six holiday-decorated homes in Kirkland, as well as a generous raffle and "after party" at Sur la Table, celebrated record attendance and a net revenue of just under \$51,000. Our Spring Event, the Kentucky Derby-themed Run for the Roses Luncheon and Fashion Show, was held at the Westin in Bellevue and added another \$75,000 to the Assistance League coffers. At the April 27<sup>th</sup> luncheon, we honored the Eastside Community Aid Thrift Shop with our 2012 National Operation School Bell Award, recognizing their contributions of over \$83,000 to our chapter in 29 separate gifts since 1993. Finally, our catch-all program for smaller fundraising campaigns, Bits n Pieces, championed CafeGive<sup>®</sup>, Celebrated Chefs, Coins for Kids, Give-A-Hug Giving Trees, the Feel Good Book Sale and the Honorariums/Memorials program.

**Fast Fact:** Assistance League of the Eastside members volunteered approximately 17,500 hours this past fiscal year. Based on guidelines provided by the U.S. Department of Labor, the estimated value of these services is \$384,000.

Aware of the fiduciary responsibilities for funds entrusted to our use, Assistance League of the Eastside continued to follow the BBB/Wise Giving Alliance Standards for Charitable Accountability in fiscal year 2011-2012. Following our mission of putting caring and commitment into action, 84% of every dollar spent went directly to the community through our philanthropic programs.

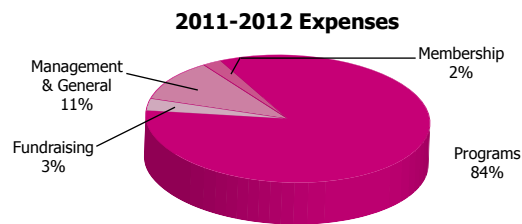
