It began to make a pupa around itself.

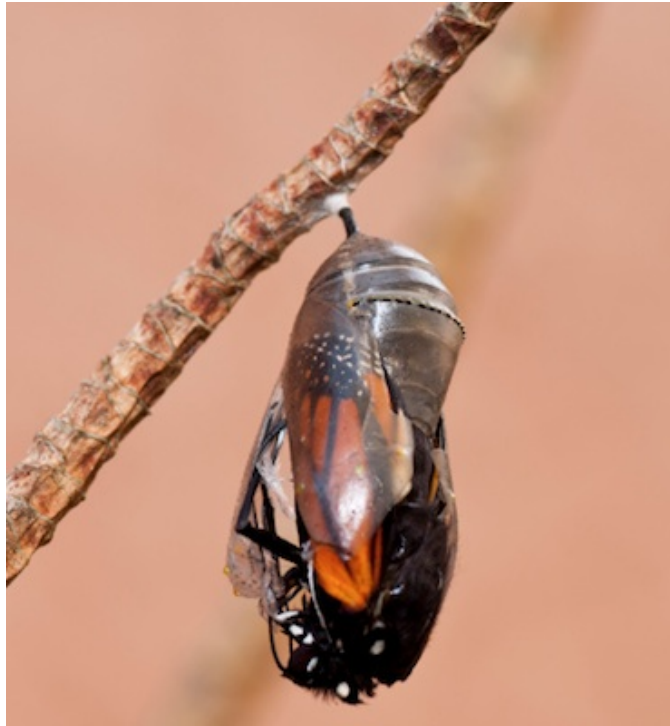


The caterpillar was inside the pupa.

A butterfly came out slowly.



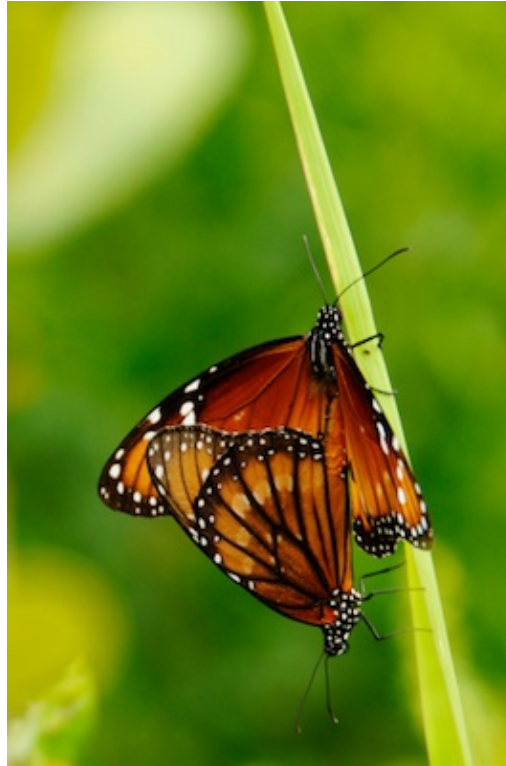


It slowly stretched its wings so they could dry.

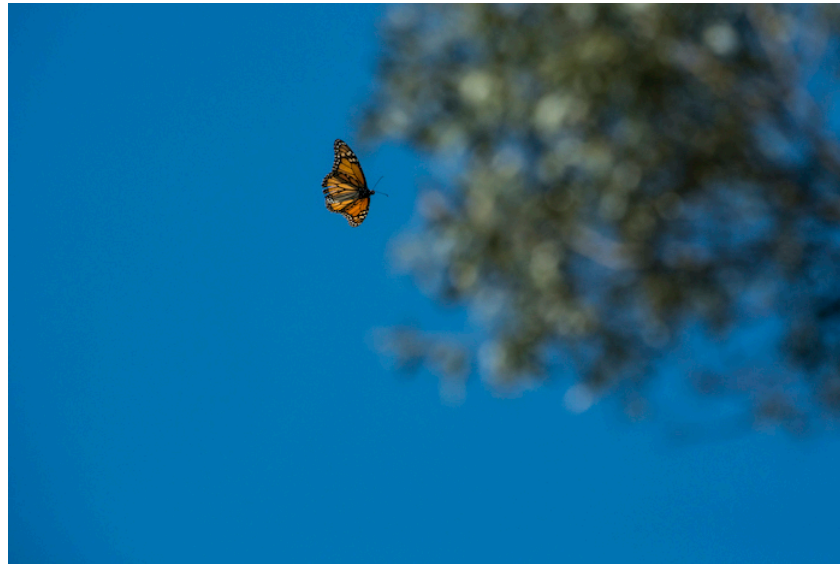
The butterfly flew to a flower so it could eat.
