Notice to the Public:

The Colville Tribes Resident Fish Hatchery staff released over 12,900 triploid rainbow trout into Rufus Woods Lake on

February 28, 2017. The fish average almost two pounds each and can be identified by the absence of an adipose fin. Of this group, approximately 20 percent were implanted with a plastic anchor tag. Anglers that retain tagged fish are encouraged to contact the Colville Confederated Tribes (CCT) Fish and Wildlife Department and provide tag number and information related to the catch (i.e.



date, location, length, and the approximate size) or login into www.cctfwfishtags.com/report-a-tag to report a tagged fish electronically. This information assists CCT biologists in managing annual fish releases into Rufus Woods Lake.

We encourage the membership to take advantage of this opportunity the hatchery is providing.
