**2017 CCT Tribal Member Fishing Regulations**

**In-Season Regulation Change**

**Action:**

Per the CCT F&W Director, salmon fishing in the mainstem Columbia River, the Okanogan River and at the Chief Joseph Dam Tailrace is closed immediately.

**Justification:**

ESA-unlisted Upper Columbia River (UCR) summer/fall Chinook and Coho in the Columbia River above Wells are no longer available for tribal harvest. Summer steelhead have not returned in numbers large enough to justify opening a tribal steelhead fishery.

All tribal member salmon and steelhead fisheries are closed at this time.
