On Wednesday August 8TH, 2018 at 6:00am the IFPL will move to a “4” and the fire Danger will move to an “EXTREME” for everything south of the Columbia River road to Highway 155 and south of Highway 155 to Peter Dan/Manilla Crk Rd and everything south of Peter Dan/Manilla Crk Rd to Highway 21. The rest of the Reservation will move to IFPL 3 and “Very High” fire Danger.

Industrial Fire Precaution Levels

Level 3. Partial Shutdown – The following are prohibited except as indicated:

- Cable yarding – except that gravity operated logging systems employing nonmotorized carriages or approved motorized carriages may operate between 8 p.m. and 1 p.m. when all block and moving lines, except for the line between the carriage and the chokers, are suspended ten feet above the ground;
- Power saws – except power saws may be used at loading sites and on tractor/skidder operations between the hours of 8 p.m. and 1 p.m. local time.

In addition, the following are permitted to operate between the hours of 8 p.m. and 1 p.m. local time:

- Tractor, skidder, feller-buncher, forwarder, or shovel logging operations where tractors, skidders, or other equipment with a blade capable of constructing fireline, are immediately available to quickly reach and effectively attack a fire start;
- Mechanized loading and hauling of any product or material;
- Blasting
- Welding or cutting of metal.

Level 4. General Shutdown – All operations are prohibited.

NOTE: Where hauling involves transit through more than one shutdown/regulating use area, the precaution level at the woods loading site shall govern the level of haul restriction, unless otherwise prohibited by other than the industrial precaution level system.
